

Bachelor of Science in Medical Imaging Curriculum

- Although our courses are individual, material required for the medical imaging student is spread across the curriculum, therefore, there is some overlap in bibliographic references.
- Dr. Rita Fisher is listed as instructor of record for most coursework. Additional faculty includes: Karen Foster, Debby Moore and Pam Haun. Upon approval of the degree/program, the School of Medical Imaging will add an additional faculty member.
- Clinical practicum courses are listed as clinic. A course with a lab component means some portion of the class will be conducted in the simulation laboratory at the St. Mary's Center for Education.
- St. Mary's has all the required contracts for clinical affiliations. No additional contracts are required at this time. The School of Medical Imaging will be responsible if additional clinical affiliations are added in the future. All clinical affiliations meet Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT) standards.
- The new Center for Education will have a computer lab that will accommodate up to 80 students, a large multipurpose simulation laboratory, and all necessary equipment. The CFE has a medical library. Marshal University will not be responsible for any additional equipment or other resources.
- All MI coursework will be taught at the CFE by CFE personnel. Any additional faculty that may be required will be hired by St. Mary's Medical Center.
