# Financial Aid Tasks and Timeline for 2014 Fall Incoming Class

### October 2013

- Begin visiting www.marshall.edu/sfa to learn about costs and scholarship, grant, loan and work-study opportunities at Marshall
- Begin your search for private scholarships (Do not pay a fee to apply for scholarships!)

## November/December 2013

- Marshall University Scholarship Award offers begin
- Application for WV Promise Scholarship Program is available at www.cfwv.com

#### January 2014

- Parent and student must apply for U.S. Department of Education (FAFSA) P.I.N. at www.pin.ed.gov
- File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov as soon as possible after
   January 1 using estimated 2013 income information if necessary. You will be able to update your income information on the FAFSA by using the FAFSA IRS tax retrieval tool after you have filed your income tax return(s).
- Be sure you list Marshall University's code (003815) on your FAFSA as a college choice
- January 4 is the deadline for all Yeager Scholar application materials to be received by the Honors College at www.marshall.edu/yeager

#### March 2014

- March 1 is Marshall University's preferred FAFSA filing deadline to be considered for most financial aid programs
- Promise Scholarship Applicants must complete the Promise Scholarship Application and file the FAFSA by March 1

#### April/May 2014

- WV residents must file the FAFSA by April 15 for WV Higher Education Grant consideration
- Keep an eye out for your Marshall University Financial Aid Award Notice (you will be able to view and accept your awards by logging into your myMU account) refer to your MU email often
- Look for WV Promise Scholarship and WV Higher Education Grant Program notifications from WV Higher Education Policy Commission
- Submit any requested information or documents, if requested, to Marshall University SFA Office as soon as
  possible, but no later than May 1 to ensure aid is finalized by the billing due date (view any outstanding financial
  aid requirements by logging into your myMU account)
- May 15 is the deadline for Honors College eligible students to accept Honors Scholarship award and admission into the Honors College

#### June/July/August 2014

- June 7 (must register by May 28) is the last date to take the SAT and June 14 (must register by May 23) is the
  last day to take the ACT for consideration of the WV Promise Scholarship
- Federal Direct Loan (FDL) borrowers should complete online Entrance Loan Counseling and sign an electronic Master Promissory Note (eMPN) at www.studentloans.gov by July 1
- Federal Work-study employees should complete and submit required Student Employment paperwork to the Office of SFA by August 1
