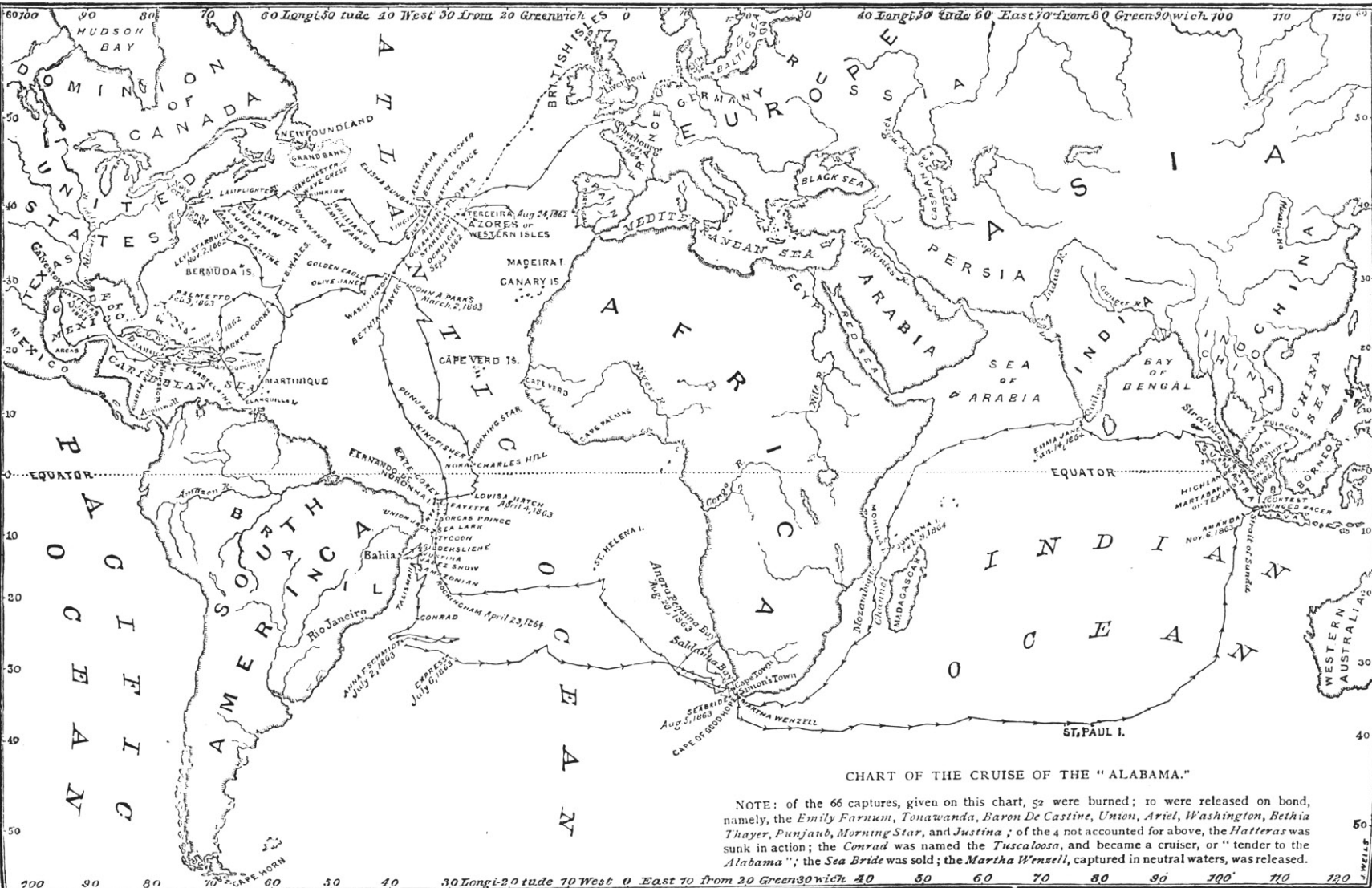


CHART OF THE CRUISE OF THE "ALABAMA."

NOTE: of the 66 captures, given on this chart, 52 were burned; 10 were released on bond, namely, the *Emily Farnum*, *Tonawanda*, *Baron De Castine*, *Union*, *Ariel*, *Washington*, *Bethia Thayer*, *Punjaub*, *Morning Star*, and *Justina*; of the 4 not accounted for above, the *Hatteras* was sunk in action; the *Conrad* was named the *Tuscaloosa*, and became a cruiser, or "tender to the *Alabama*"; the *Sea Bride* was sold; the *Martha Wenzell*, captured in neutral waters, was released.
