Note for paper sessions: Projectors and laptop computers will be available. Internet access is not available for presentations. Presenters should bring 15 copies of the paper to the conference for distribution and an electronic copy of the paper at registration. Copies of PowerPoint presentations are not acceptable in lieu of a complete scholarly paper with documentation and bibliography of references.

Note for round table sessions: A round table setting will be available for presenters to discuss their scholarly work with interested attendants. At a minimum, round table presenters should provide an abstract to share with the attendants.
