2 points for each year of involvement in an honor club

1 point for each year of committee membership

1 point for each year of involvement in an organization

*To further take into account depth of leadership, a student will be awarded 1 additional point in any area in which he/she has held 3 or more offices. Examples: 3 or more offices in the Greek system.

1 point for each area of involvement

Plus points for total overall hours of service:

Achievements

3 points for major achievement

-athletic letter, Yeager Scholar, competitive scholarship, academic scholarship, athletic scholarship, etc.

2 points for each year of membership in competitive roles

-lead in play, captain of athletic team, etc.

1 point each per additional year of scholarship awarded

Special Considerations

4 points awarded for involvement in the following

- HELP Program, working full-time, parent to school-age or younger children, and military service.

3 points for part time work 30-39 hours per week

2 points for part time work 20-29 hours per week

1 point for part time work 1-19 hours per week
