A **No Contact Order** will be put in place immediately, but we do not have the authority to issue legal Emergency or Final Protective Orders. A Conduct Officer will conduct an investigation following Due Process, which may include speaking with all parties involved, including witnesses.

Students have the right to choose and consult with an Advisor, who may be any person. The Advisor may provide support and advice to the Complainant at any meeting.


