Sexual Misconduct is covered by the 2nd standard of the Student Code of Conduct

If an act of sexual misconduct occurs outside of campus property, it falls within the jurisdiction of the Office of Student Conduct.

Sexual assault, abuse, stalking or misconduct, including any sexual acts committed without the affirmative consent of the victim and any other violations of University policies regarding sexual harassment as defined in and governed by the Discrimination, Harassment, Sexual Harassment, Sexual & Domestic Misconduct, Stalking, And Retaliation, Board of Governors Policy, GA-1.



5.2.2.4

Relationship Violence which causes physical harm or abuse, and threats of physical harm, restraint or abuse, arising out of a relationship as defined in and governed by the University Discrimination, Harassment, Sexual Harassment, Sexual & Domestic Misconduct, Stalking And Retaliation Board of Governors Policy, GA-1.



Our office is *not equivalent to a criminal process*, and complainants are encouraged to seek support outside of campus as well.



A No Contact Order will be put in place immediately, but we do not have the authority to issue legal Emergency or Final Protective Orders.

A Conduct Officer will conduct an investigation following Due Process, which may include speaking with all parties involved, including witnesses.

Students have the right to choose and consult with an Advisor, who may be any person. The Advisor may provide support and advice to the Complainant at any meeting.

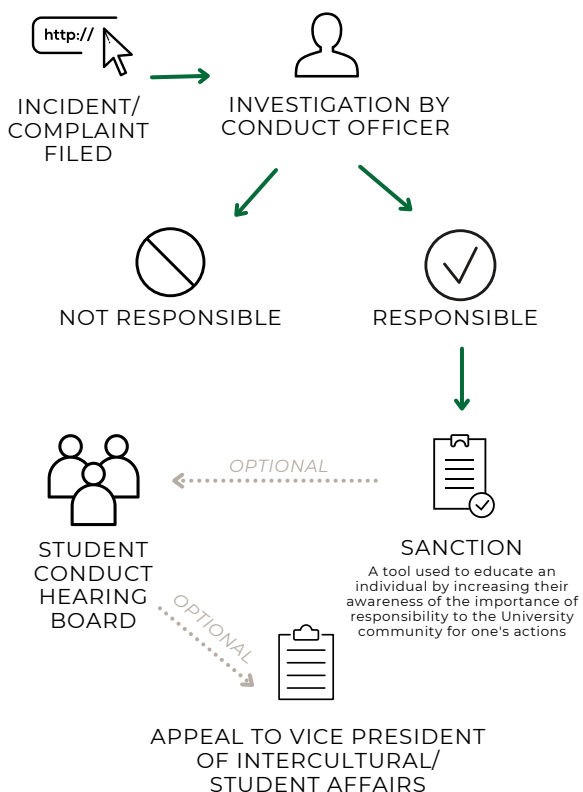

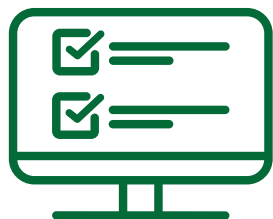

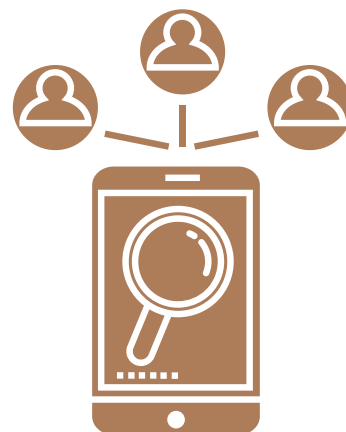
