Dark Sky *By Jon Reed*

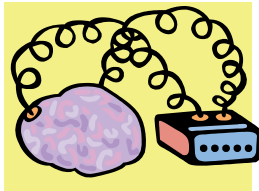
Darkness

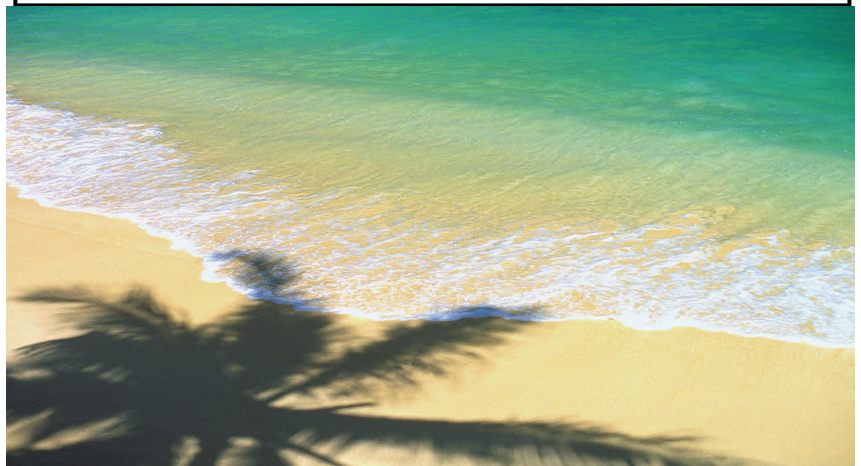
