I can't believe we are knocking on the door of October and that you have been back in school for over 6 weeks... time flies! I hope the school year has started off well for all of you.

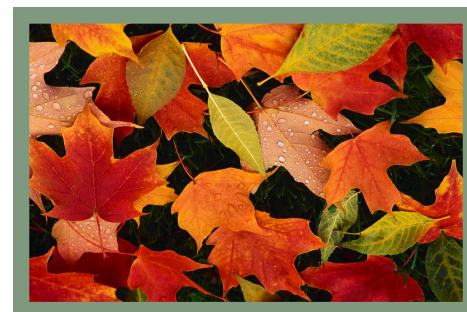

Tutoring

Before attending tutoring go to your school coordinator and get a tutoring slip. Have your tutor fill out a slip each time you attend tutoring and turn it back into your coordinator to send to the Upward Bound office. We must receive a tutoring slip for you to get credit for attendance.

If an Upward Bound student receives a D or below in a class, then tutoring must be attended for a **total of four hours** during the next six-week grading period. If four hours are not attended, then \$15 will be deducted from the next stipend.

If your school offers tutoring, please go to it and they will fill out your slip. In the next month we will be setting up peer tutors to work with you as well.

All Upward Bound students are welcome to attend tutoring at any time for help with class work. Always bring something to work on and use your time wisely.

We will also be doing carry out so they can call and place an order that day by calling (304) 840--4289.

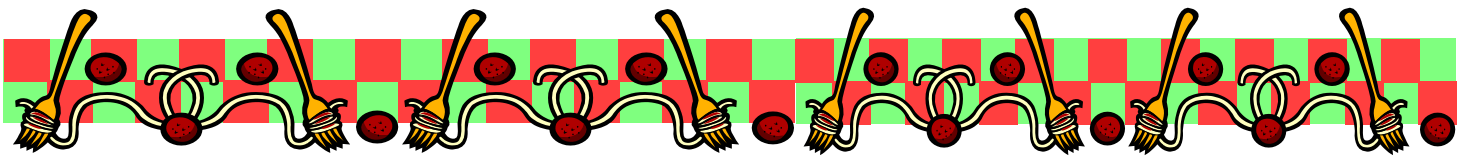

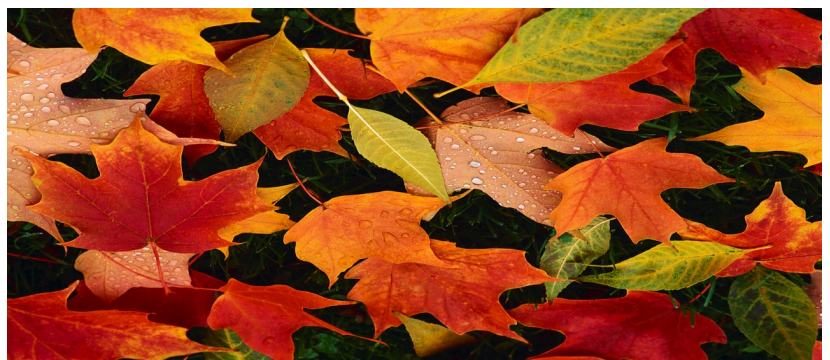
