The application for Summer Program employment is on the next page.

The deadline is April 3, 2013. Fill out and return to Mrs. Collier or your in-school coordinator or mail to Upward Bound Office, Marshall University, One John Marshall Drive, Huntington, WV 25755.

In order to qualify for employment it is recommended that it not be your first summer program and that you have a cumulative gpa of 2.5 or better. The schedule you will be expected to work will be as follows:

Monday - Thursday I- 4 pm

If student is required to take a language class then their schedule will be adjusted and may include working on Fridays.

Make sure that you email Roxanne at skilesp@marshall.edu or call (304) 696-6462 to confirm that application has been received in the office.

She will not be able to place you in a position without receiving the application.

It is important that you work all the hours your are scheduled to work in order to receive your full work study stipend. Please do not apply if you are not serious about working.

If all hours are worked, you will be paid \$310.00 at end of the program.


