

The deadline is March 27, 2015. Fill out and return to Darlene Collier or your in-school coordinator or mail to the Upward Bound Office, Marshall University, One John Marshall Drive, Huntington, WV 25755.

In order to qualify for employment, it is recommended that it not be your first summer program and that you have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better.

If student is required to take a language class then their schedule will be adjusted and may include working on Fridays.
