



Late Fees will be required if you register after the deadline for all tests. The UB waivers are not valid if you register late.





## Upward Bound Officers' Duties and Responsibilities

Each school's Upward Bound (UB) program operates like a club during the school year. This year there will be a President, Vice-President and Secretary/Treasurer at each school. These officers will be elected by the club members during the first Upward Bound club meeting. The following is a description of each position and what is expected. When nominating someone for a position, please make sure the person considered is willing and capable of fulfilling the obligations and requirements for that position. Your school's UB club will only run as well as the officers in charge. Remember that the Coordinator is available to help, but this is YOUR program!

#### President

- **Be a model Upward Bound member**
- > Attend meetings and activities faithfully
- > Work with Coordinator to plan club meetings
- Notify club members of meetings
- > Notify club members of activities and changes/cancellations of activities
- > Work with Coordinator on any fundraisers
- Be a positive representative of Upward Bound to the teachers, administrators and other students

### Vice-President

- Actively assist President in duties listed above
- > Step in when President is unable to fulfill duties

### Secretary/Treasurer

- Take minutes at each meeting and provide them to Coordinators, detailing what is discussed during the meeting
- > Record attendance at each meeting on monthly attendance sheet for Coordinator
- > Pass out newsletters and any forms from UB office
- Take up any completed forms and give them to Coordinator to return to UB office (address updates, stipend receipts, permission slips, etc.)
- Count and record any money raised in fundraisers and provide Coordinator with records and money to be turned into UB office as soon as possible
