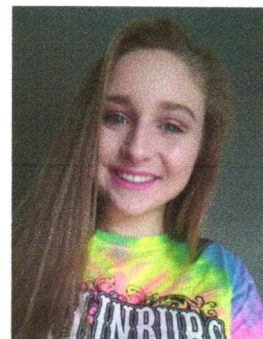

As the school year begins to wind down, enjoy the warmer weather and your Spring Break, but don't get spring fever! Work to the very end!

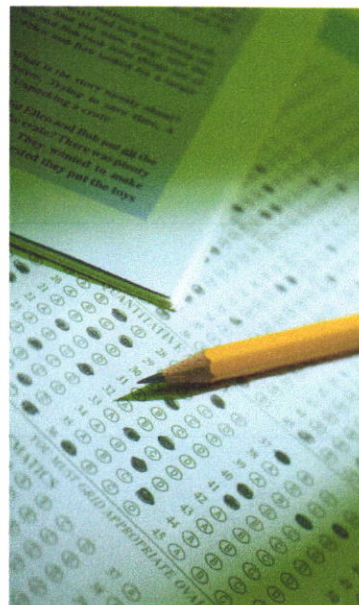
