


Congratulations to Courtaenae Lopez! The Barboursville Mall Walmart has agreed to give 2 seniors at Huntington High School a \$250 scholarship!

As the school year begins to wind down, enjoy the warmer weather and your Spring Break, but don't get spring fever! Work to the very end!




Students: Remember that as a part of the Upward Bound Program, you receive two waivers for the ACT Testing. Ask Eugene for more information.


