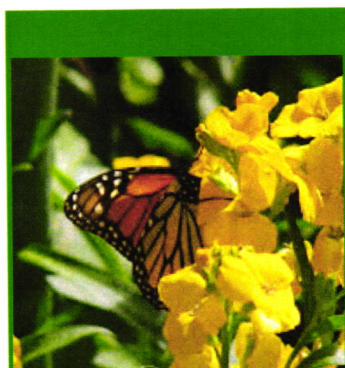

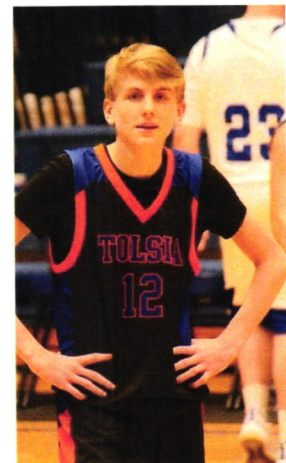

Attending the Summer Program is one of the ways Upward Bound prepares you for college.

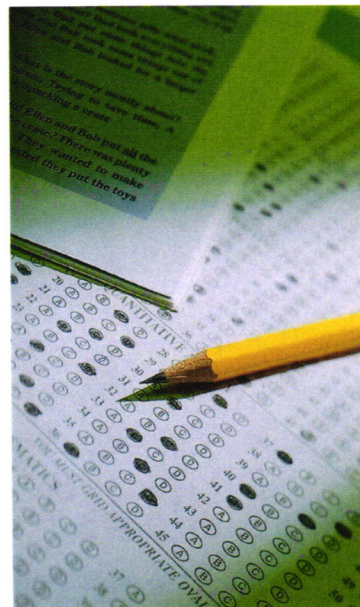
