May

- May 14, 1607 - The first permanent English settlement in America was established at Jamestown, Virginia, by a group of royally chartered Virginia Company settlers from Plymouth, England.

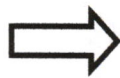
- May 17, 1875 - The first Kentucky Derby horse race took place at Churchill Downs in Louisville

- May 17, 1954- In Brown v. Board of Education, the U.S. Supreme Court unanimously ruled that separate educational facilities are inherently unequal.

- May 20, 1932 - Amelia Earhart became the first woman to fly solo across the Atlantic. Five years later, along with her navigator Fred Noonan, she disappeared while trying to fly her twin-engine plane around the equator.

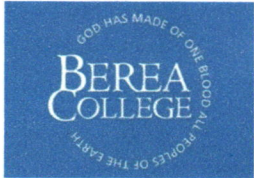
