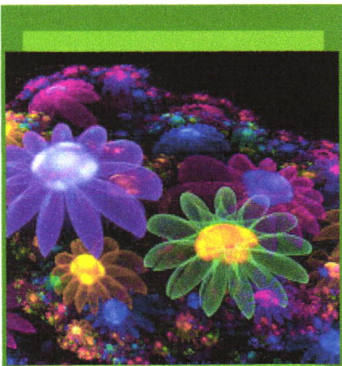

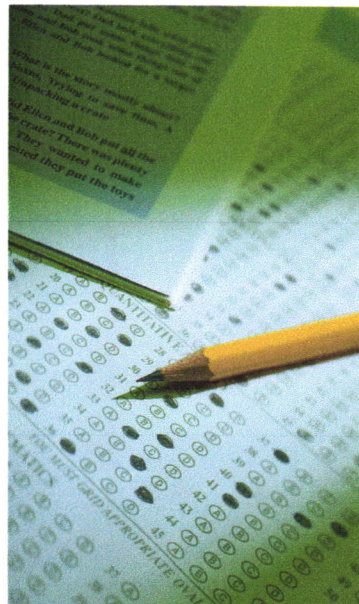

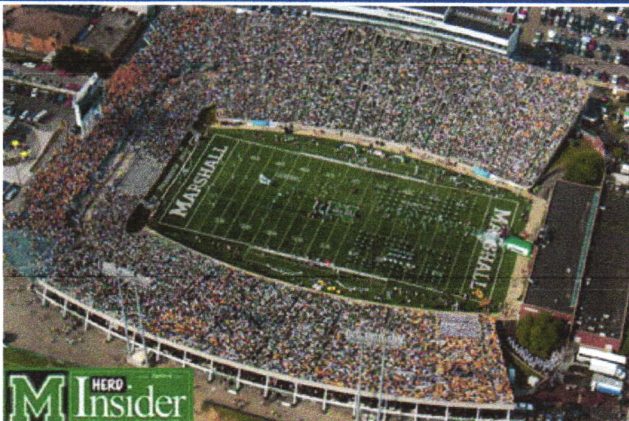

- ◆ MU has 16 NCAA Division I sports and is part of Conference USA. MU also has 10 clubs and 32 intramural sports.

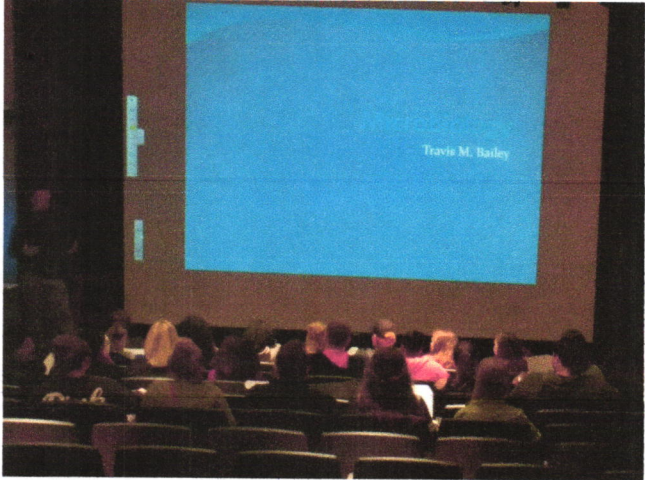

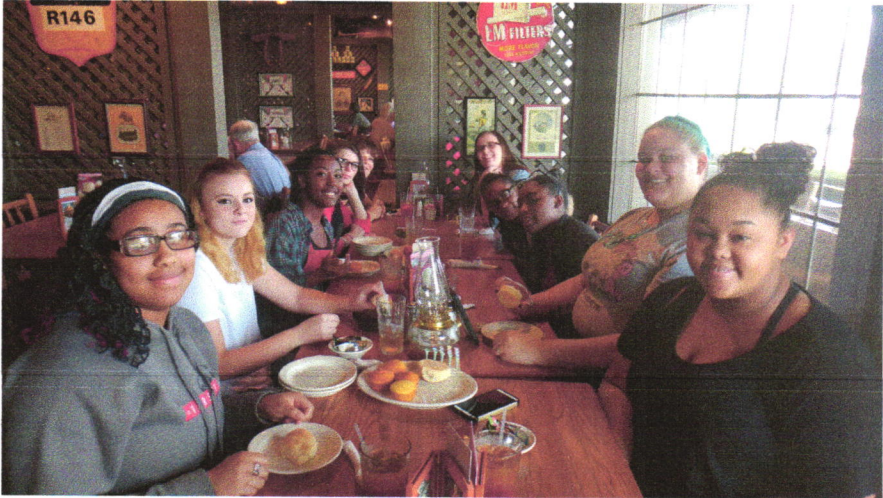
