completed and mailed to us ASAP! Please contact us if you have any questions!

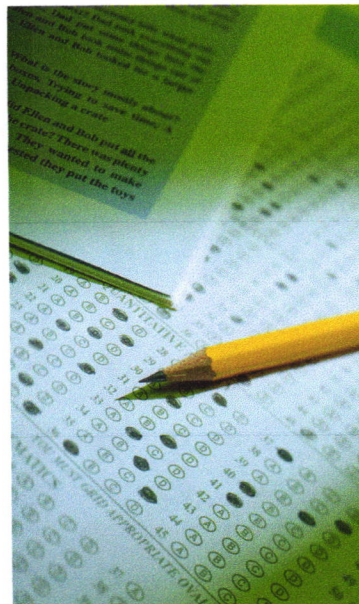

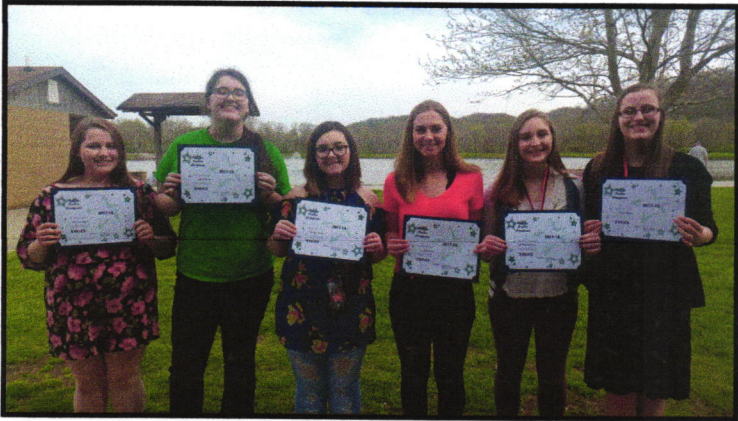
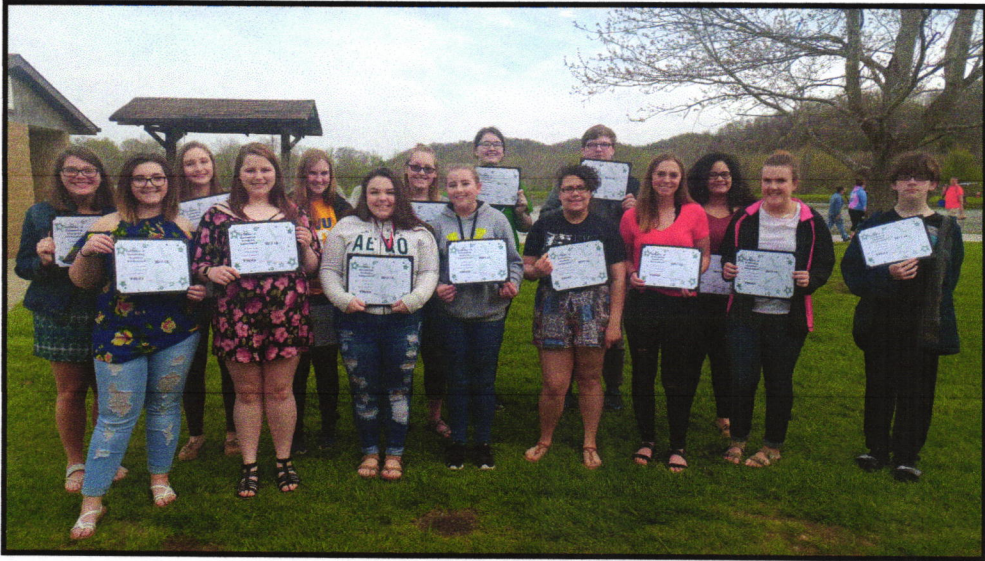
