Featured College: Alice Lloyd College "Eagles"



- ♦ Alice Lloyd College's (ALC) mission is to make education available to qualified mountain students regardless of their financial situation.
- ♦ ALC is one of seven work-study colleges in the nation. All full-time students at ALC work at least 10 hours a week to offset the cost of their education. Jobs in the Student Work Program range from grounds and janitorial duties to office positions and teaching assistants.
- ♦ All students in the 108-county service area do not pay any out-of-pocket costs for tuition while attending ALC through the Appalachian Leaders College Scholarship. This money is provided through the generous donations of people across the country.
- ♦ ALC offers a high quality academic program, emphasizing the liberal arts.
- ♦ Character building is essential at ALC. Christian principles are integrated into all aspects of campus life. Students are expected to follow set rules and guidelines for good moral development and social behavior. Faculty and staff serve as role models and lead by example.
- ♦ ALC has 5 men and 7 women NAIA sports and is part of the River States Conference.
