

Installing the VPN Client

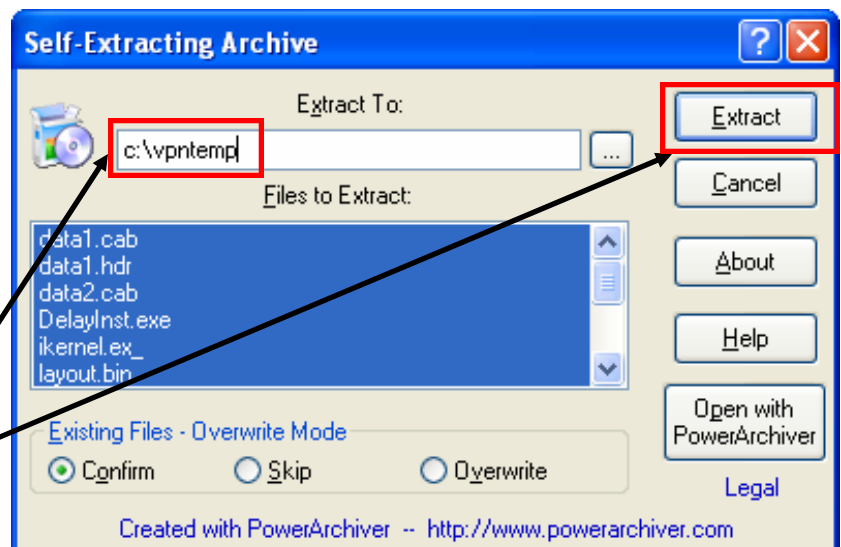
The VPN (Virtual Private Networking) acts as a private network while still using public lines, allowing both off campus computers and on campus wireless users the appearance of a dedicated network connection.

To begin, download the MUNet VPN Client executable from the following webpage:

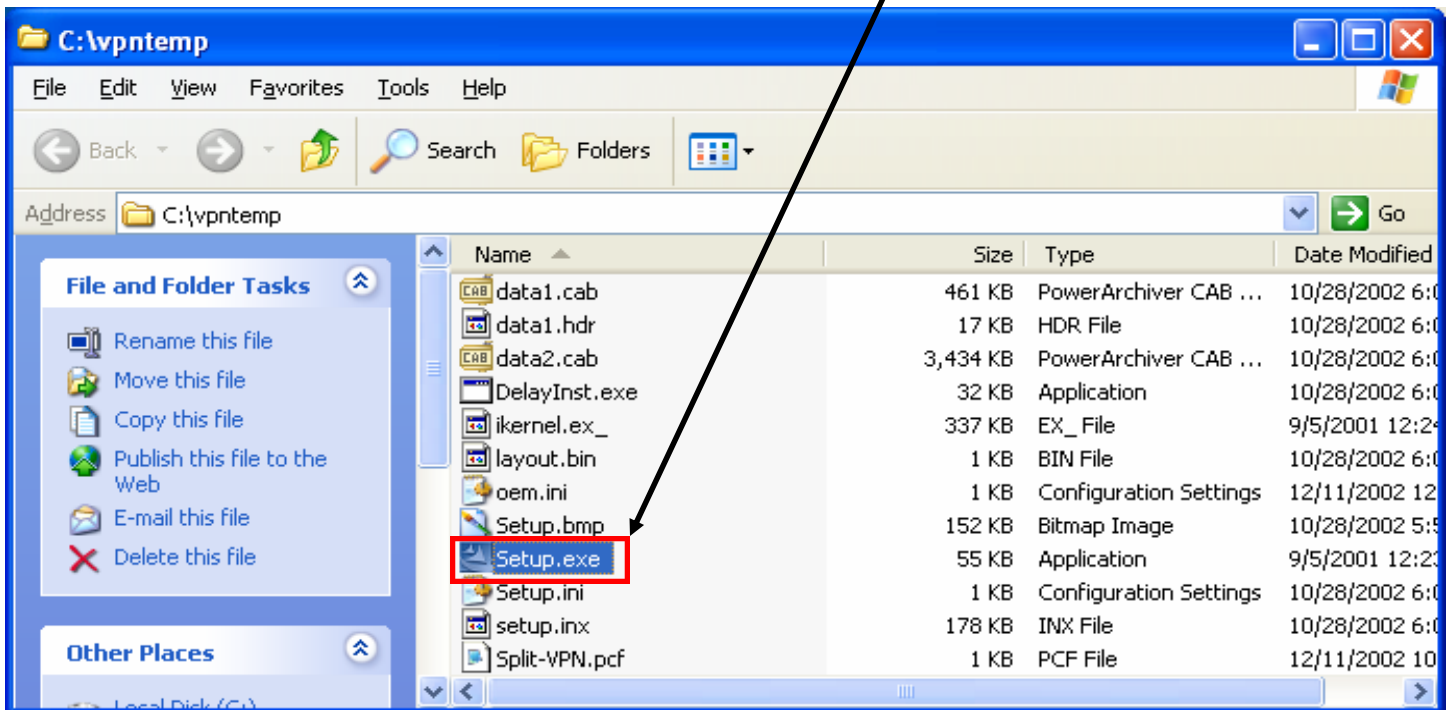

You must have an MUNet account to download this client. If you don't have an account, you can contact the Computing Services Help-Desk to find out if you are eligible.

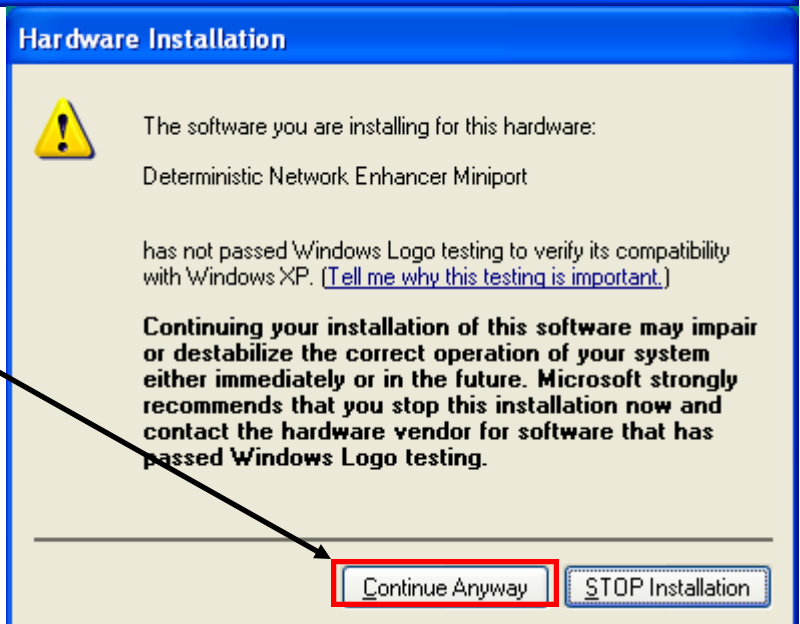
Save the file to your computer and double click the executable to run it. You will see the extraction dialog window. Change the save location to a folder such as C:\vpntemp. Click the "Extract" button.



Double click the folder you created, find the "Setup.exe" file and double click it to start the installation.



Some versions of Windows XP may indicate a testing issue with the installation. If this window appears, click "Continue Anyway" to continue with the installation.



When the install is finished, make sure you click "Yes" to restart your computer.
