Download

1. After reading the Export Compliance Disclaimer click **Download**.

You will be asked to authenticate yourself by entering "**marshall\username**" and then your **password**.
2. When the File Download window appears, **click Save**
3. Choose "**Desktop**" as the location. **Click "Ok"**.
4. If the Download Complete window appears, **click Close**. The file icon appears on your desktop.

Install

1. Press the "Windows" + "M" keys at the same time to minimize all the open windows.
2. **Find the downloaded file on your Desktop and double-click it.**
NOTE: If the Security Warning window appears, click "Yes".
3. **Click "Setup"**. A DOS Window appears.
4. **Press the "Enter" key.**
5. Insert the floppy disk into the floppy disk drive and **press the "Enter" key.**
6. **Press the "Y" key** to begin copying files. An End of the disk set prompt appears.
7. **Press the "Enter" key.**
8. **Click the "Start" button, click "Run"**, and then type a: in the Open box. **Click "OK"**. The list of files on the floppy disk appears.
9. If there is a readme file in the list, double-click it for additional instructions.
10. Close all open windows and leave the disk in the floppy drive.

NOTE: If you are creating this disk on another computer, remove the disk. Then insert it into the system that needs the BIOS flashed, and resume the procedure.
