

Yeager Senior Projects Deadlines 2009-2010

These dates are deadlines. You may present your Yeager Senior Project anytime during the spring semester; however, there is a limitation of only two presentations permitted during any week. You are strongly encouraged to progress at a rate that will allow you to present early in the semester. This will allow you to make any corrections and re-present, if necessary.

Fall Semester

November 5, 2009 Progress reports due no later than 5 pm.

1. In your report, identify your committee members and briefly describe the steps you've taken to date to conduct your research and write your report. You are required to obtain the signature of your project advisor validating your progress.

2. Attach your research report outline and/or draft with references or a list of what you've read so far related to your project. This progress report and research outline will be presented to the Yeager Steering Committee.

Spring Semester

January 25, 2010	Draft of paper due to your committee chair.
February 19, 2010	Revision due to all committee members and Yeager Steering Committee (via Dr. LoCascio)
March 15, 2010	Final draft to committee members and Yeager Steering Committee (via Dr. LoCascio)
April 12, 2010	Presentations of Yeager Senior Projects completed. (Students must schedule their own room reservations through Facilities and must ensure equipment set-up as needed)
April 28, 2010	Completed, signed projects turned in to Honor's College
May 7, 2010	Medallion Ceremony
May 8, 2010	Commencement Ceremonies

Important: Students who do not make adequate progress during their senior year put themselves in jeopardy of not receiving their medallion with the rest of their class.
