SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

- All applications will be submitted online at <https://www.marshall.edu/art-galleries/artist-opportunities/>
- Select "Call for 40th Annual Student Juried Exhibition" under "Student Opportunities"
- Prepare to complete the online form by ensuring your images or videos for entry follow the requirements listed below before the deadline date.
- Submit up to three artworks online by Friday, January 30 at 11:59:59 p.m. EST

IMAGE / VIDEO SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Images of works submitted should be high-resolution (300 ppi) no more than 24 MB. If you are unsure about this, reference Adobe.com as a resource: <https://helpx.adobe.com/photoshop/using/image-size-resolution.html>
- Submission images must be oriented properly (e.g., the top of the artwork is at the top of the image provided)
- Submission images should not include an artist's name or other descriptive text.
- All file names should be saved as lastname_entry number.jpg. Ex. Johnson_1.jpg.
- Video work must be submitted as a link to YouTube or Vimeo and include a still image.
- Images must be an accurate representation of the artwork. The juror and gallery director reserve the right to eliminate any work that does not meet standards of quality.

IMPORTANT DATES

- January 30: All entries due by 11:59:59 p.m. EST
- February 3 – 10: Juror selects works for exhibit
- February 12: Email notifications will be sent to all applicants.
- February 23 – 24: Students drop off artworks labeled and ready to display in the Birke Art Gallery between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
- March 2: Exhibition opens
- March 26: Awards Reception 6 to 8 p.m. (Awards at 6:30 p.m.)
- March 27: Exhibition closes
- March 30 - April 2: Students pick up artwork from the Birke Art Gallery between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

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ELIGIBILITY

Currently enrolled majors in Art Education, BA (Art, Art History, and Video Production), BFA, and Art Minor students. All media is considered. Students are limited to three entries. Artworks displayed in previous Annual Student Juried Exhibitions are not eligible.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL WORK ACCEPTED INTO THE EXHIBITION

- All work must be fully assembled, completely dry, and ready to display.
- All works will include a completed gallery label attached to the artwork if possible.
- Framed work and wall-hanging, three dimensional pieces must be wired securely.
- 2D works are not required to be matted and framed but it is strongly recommended. If the work is intended to be displayed without a frame, there should be instructions of how the work is to be exhibited. (e.g., magnets, t-pins, etc...)
- Installation artworks should include a printed image and instructions of how to display.
- Digital or video works must be formatted for a MICCA media player and submitted via OneDrive or a USB flash drive. Please advise if there is a preference in technology used for display (e.g., flat-screen tv, iPad, projector, etc...)

No late entries will be accepted.
