

Marshall University's School of Art & Design is pleased to invite artists to submit entries for the **16th Annual National Juried Exhibition**. Accepted works will be exhibited at the Charles W. & Norma C. Carroll Gallery in the Visual Arts Center in Huntington, WV from **January 18 to February 25, 2027**.

JUROR

This year's juror is **Rachel Rearick**, Executive Director of Contemporary Craft and adjunct faculty member at Carnegie Mellon University, teaching courses in museum operations and public art. Rearick is an artist member of the Associated Artists of Pittsburgh and the Pittsburgh Print Group.

ELIGIBILITY

- To be eligible for the exhibition, artists must be 18 years of age or older and must maintain a permanent residence in the U.S. Exceptions are made for students and military personnel with U.S. resident status.
- Artwork previously displayed in Marshall University's art galleries will not be considered.

ARTWORK SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Artists may submit up to three artworks in any medium.
- All entries must be submitted using the online entry form.
- Entry fees must be paid to be considered for the jurying process.
 - **General Public:** \$30, up to three entries | **Marshall University students:** \$15, up to three entries

CONDITIONS & RULES

- By submitting an entry to this exhibition, the artist agrees to all conditions outlined in this prospectus.
- Accepted artworks may not be withdrawn before the exhibition closes.
- The School of Art & Design reserves the right to refuse any entry if, upon arrival, the work is found to be unacceptable or significantly different from the submitted representation.
- All accepted works must be display-ready.

INSURANCE & LIABILITY

The School of Art & Design will take every precaution to safeguard leased work in its possession; however, its liability to lenders is limited. Artists whose work is accepted will receive an Art Loan Agreement form detailing any liability assigned to Marshall University. This form must be signed and returned to the Gallery Director by all participating artists before the exhibition begins.

SHIPPING & DELIVERY

The artist is responsible for all delivery costs and for insuring their artwork while it is in transit to and from the gallery.
