  - 2019-2012 CLA results, discussion of fall 2012 test administration and future plans: -
    - Value-Added at near expected level
    - Hope to give to random sample of seniors on Assessment Day this year.
  - Spring 2012 NSSE results and discussion of future plans
    - Overall response rate = 22% as compared to 25% for Carnegie peers
    - 16% to 22% for freshmen
    - 27% to 27% for Seniors
    - Improvement for freshmen in LAC and ACL – still commensurate with top 50% of NSSE institutions in LAC for freshmen.
  - 2011 – 2012 Program Assessment Report results – trends for the past several years – discuss impact of Open Pathways project
    - 45% of programs were at level 3 for feedback loop as compared to 24% year before.
    - Mean for feedback loop rose from 1.77 to 1.97
  - 2011 – 2012 Program Review Results – discussion regarding changes implemented in academic year 2012 – 2013
    - Discuss changes for accredited programs
  - General Education – discussion of proposal to revise core domains of thinking and more clearly articulate outcomes for each
