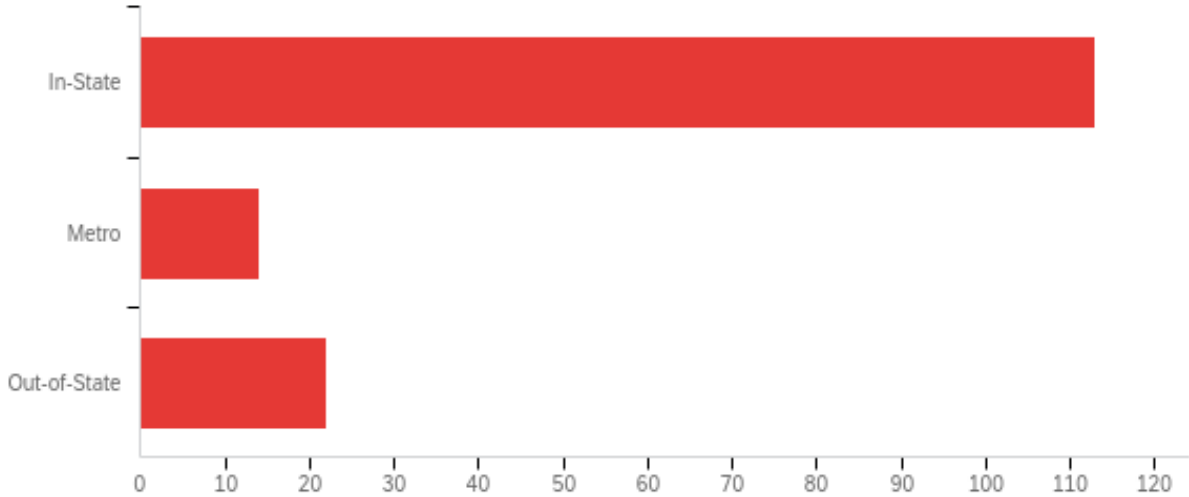

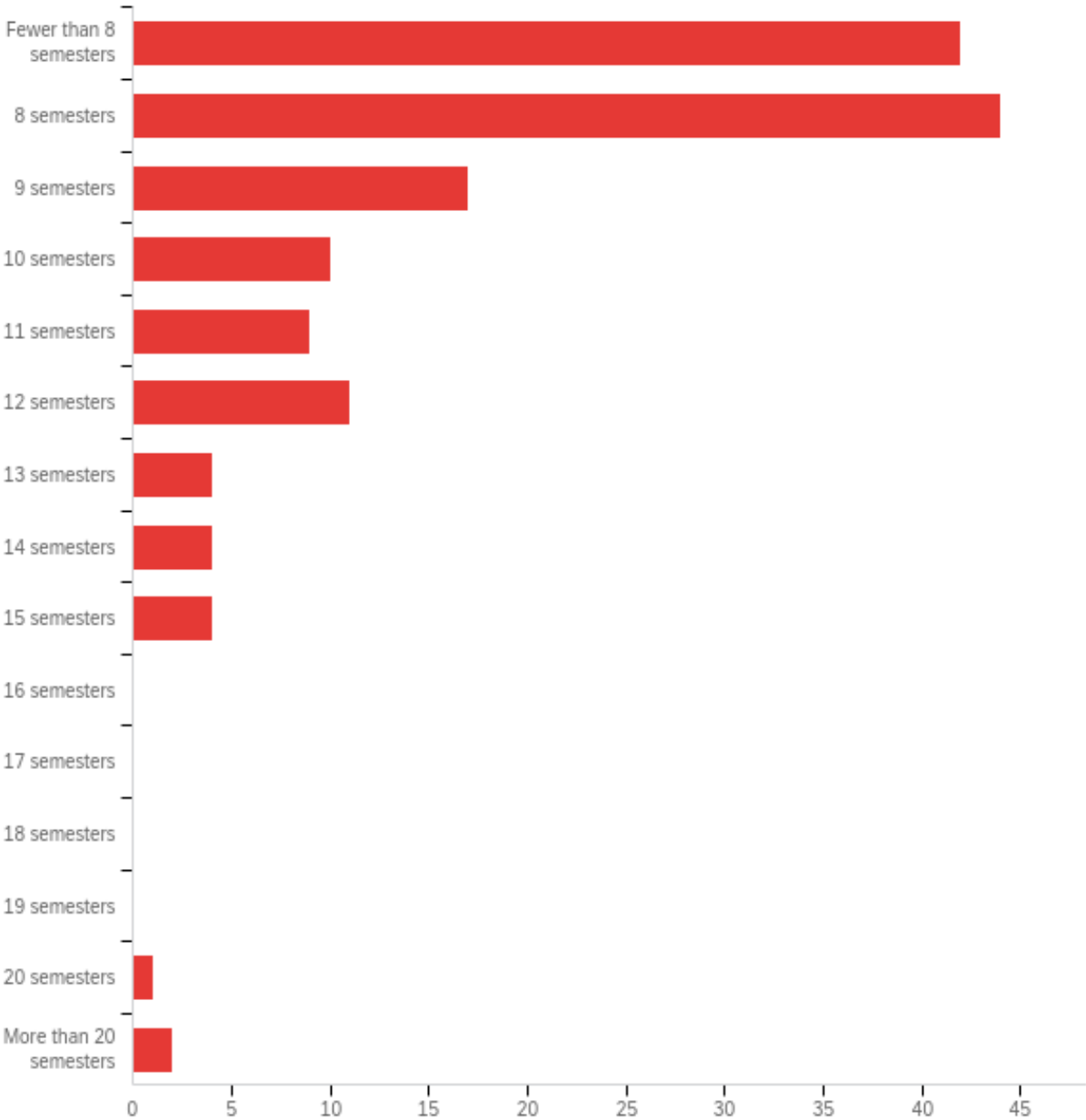

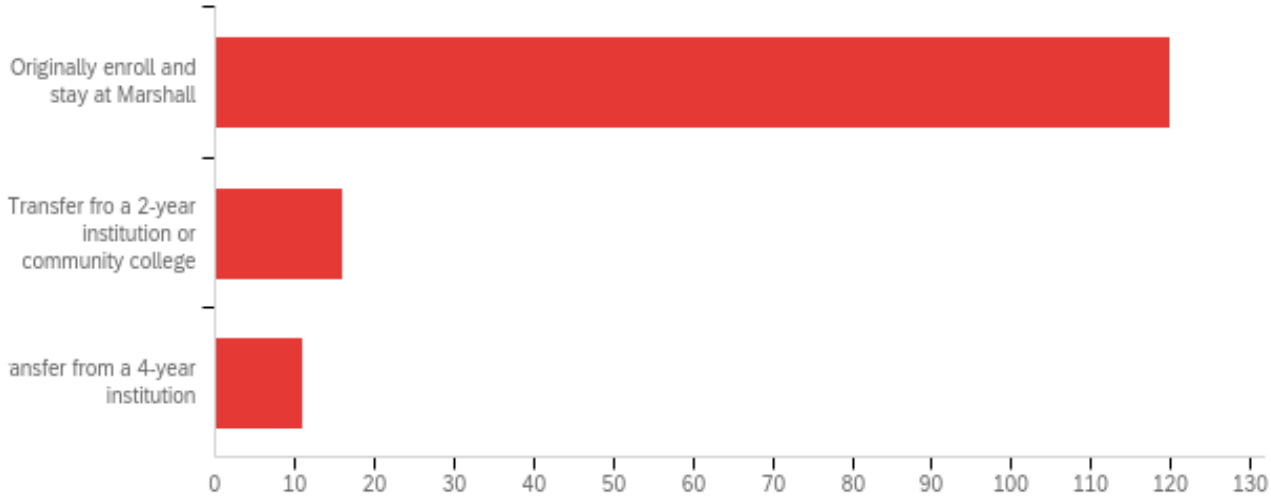

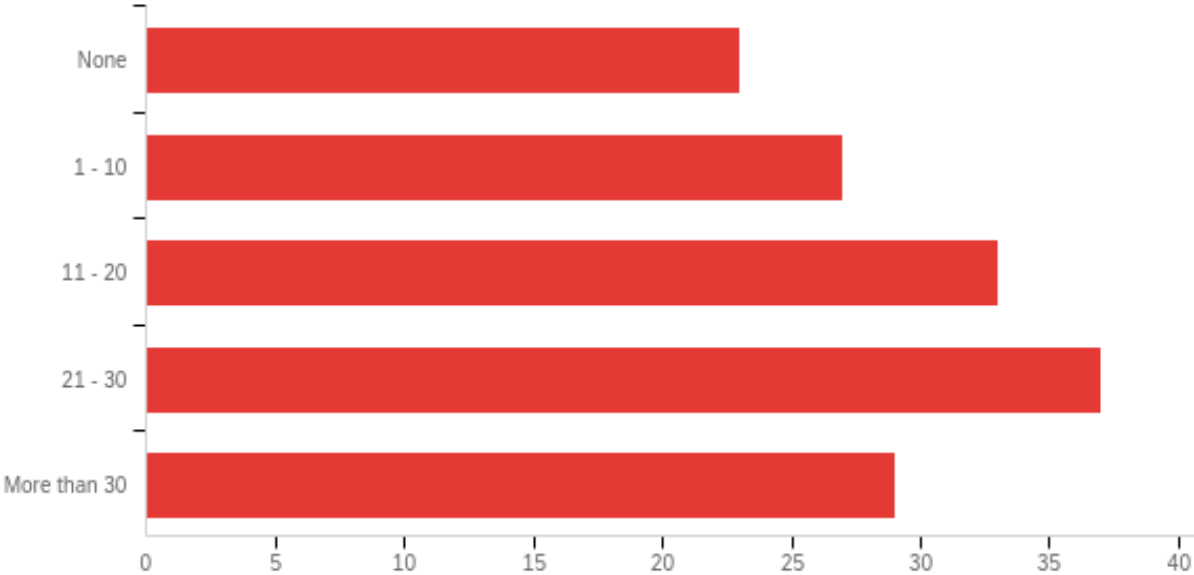

Q12 - While pursuing your degree, did you



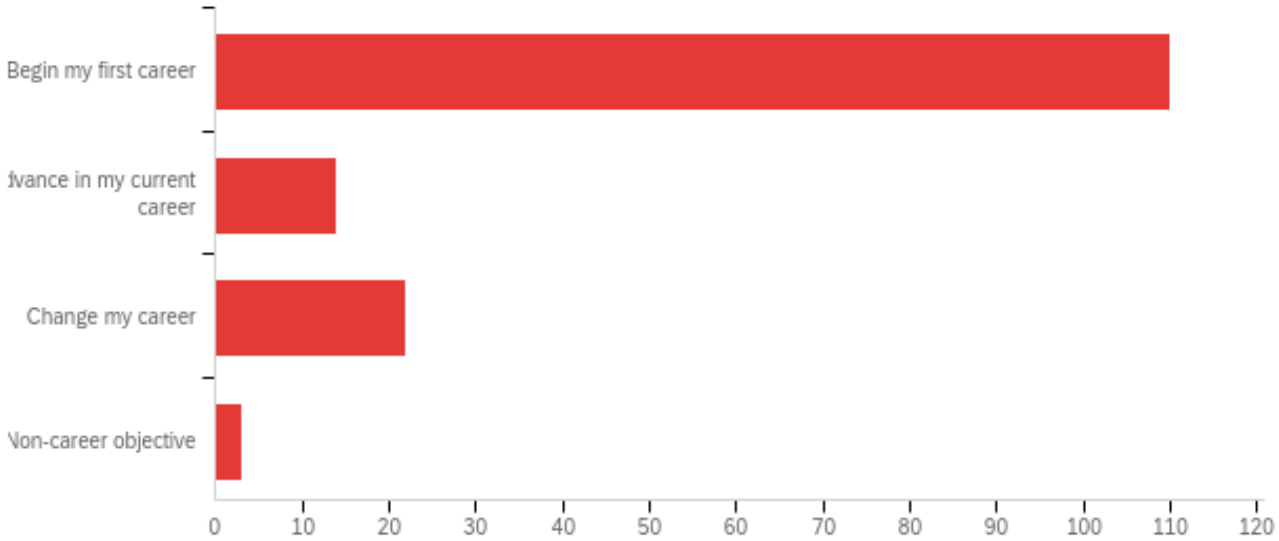

Q13 - During the last year of your studies, how many hours a week did you work while attending classes?



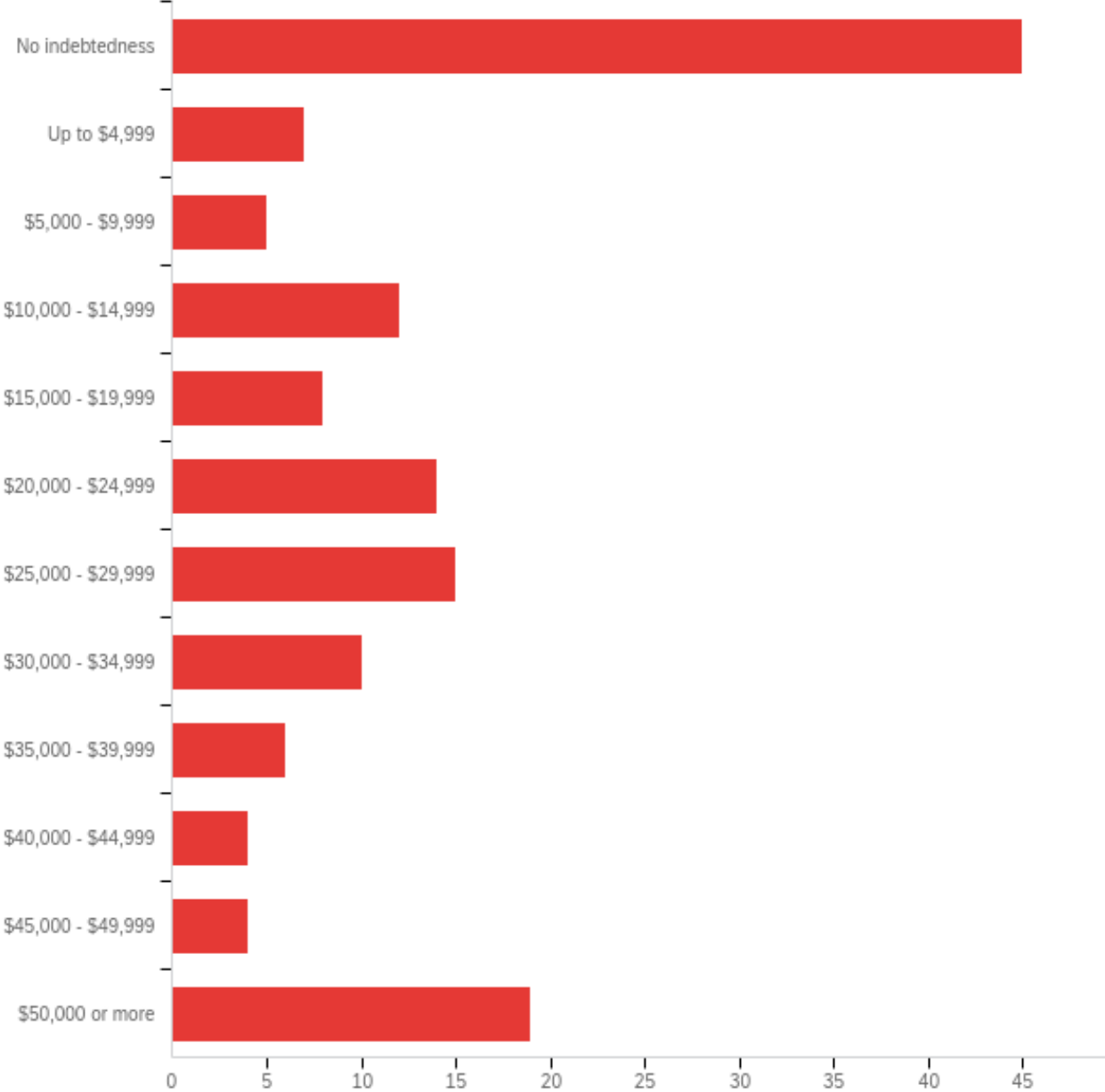

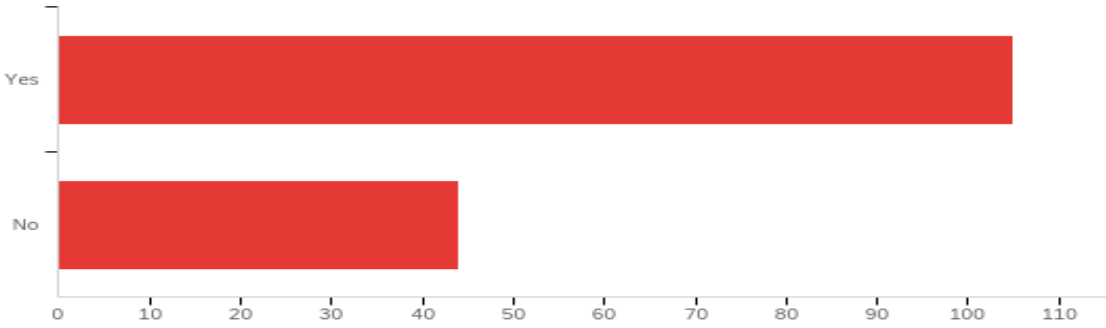

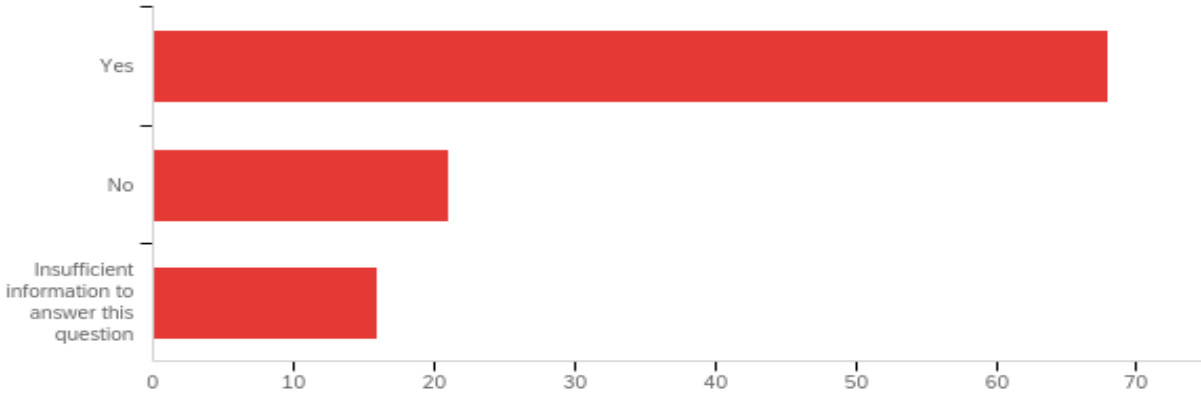
