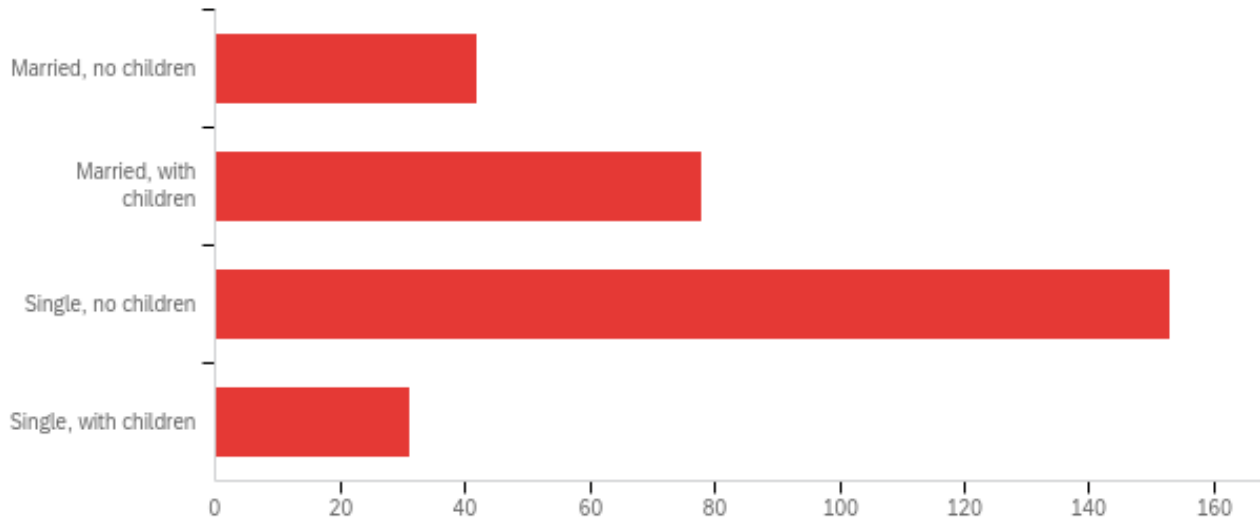




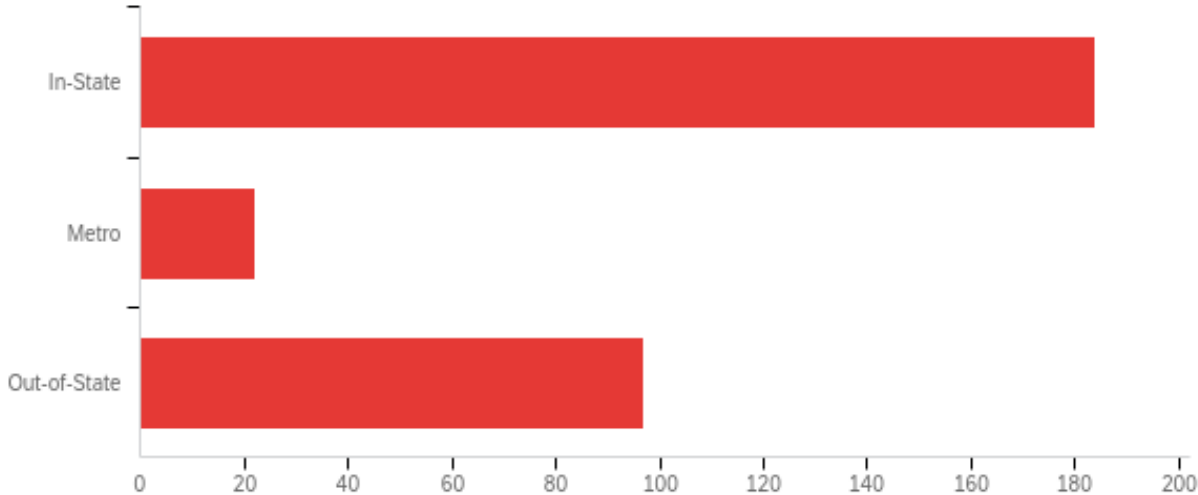

Q1 - Family Status



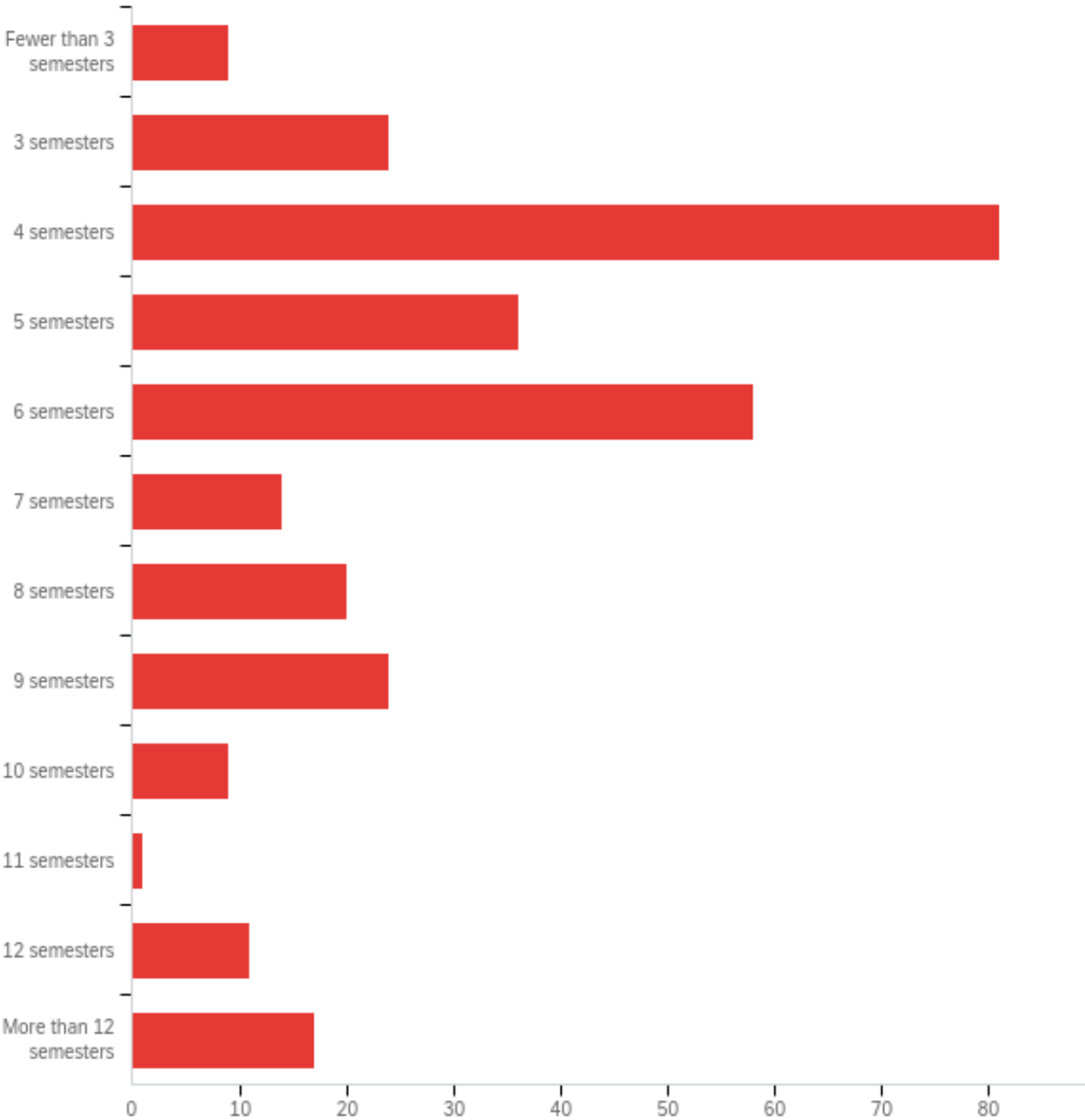

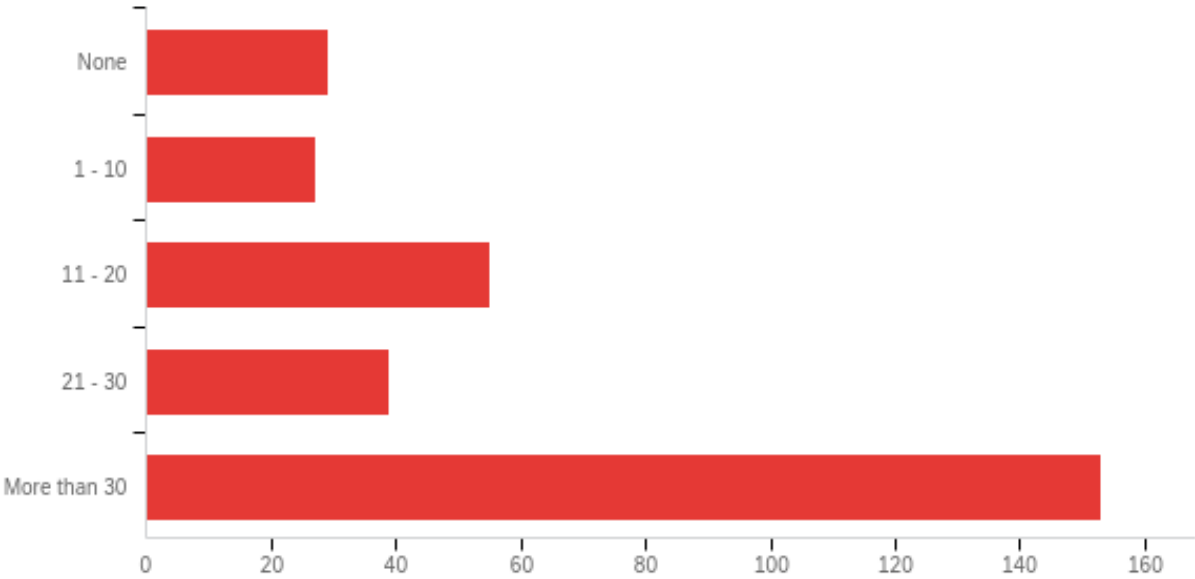

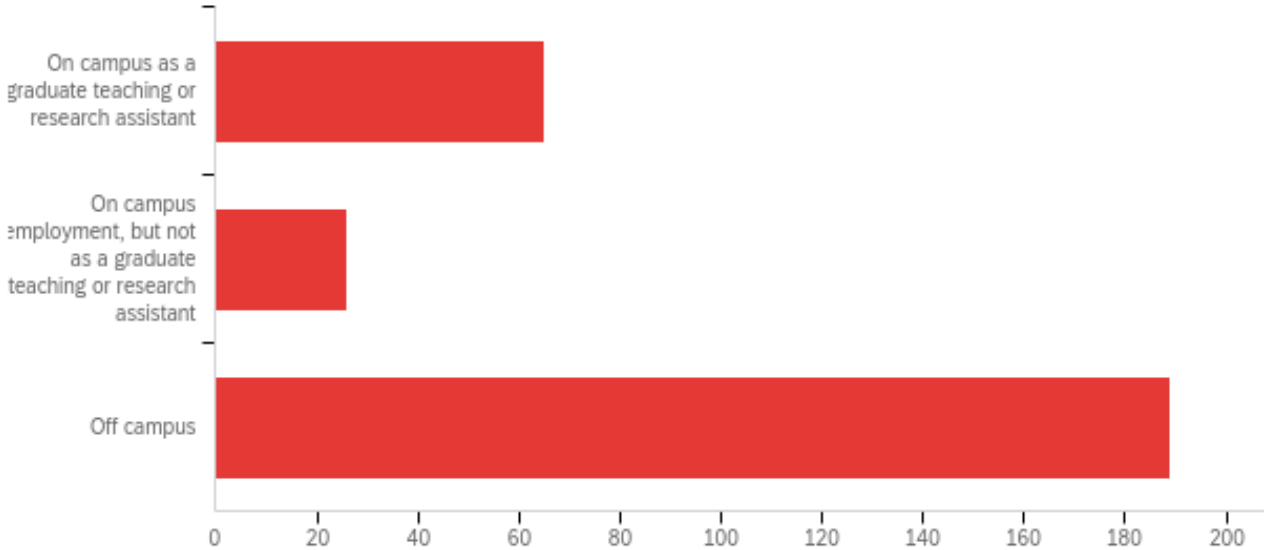

Q4 - During the last year of your studies, how many hours a week did you work while attending classes?



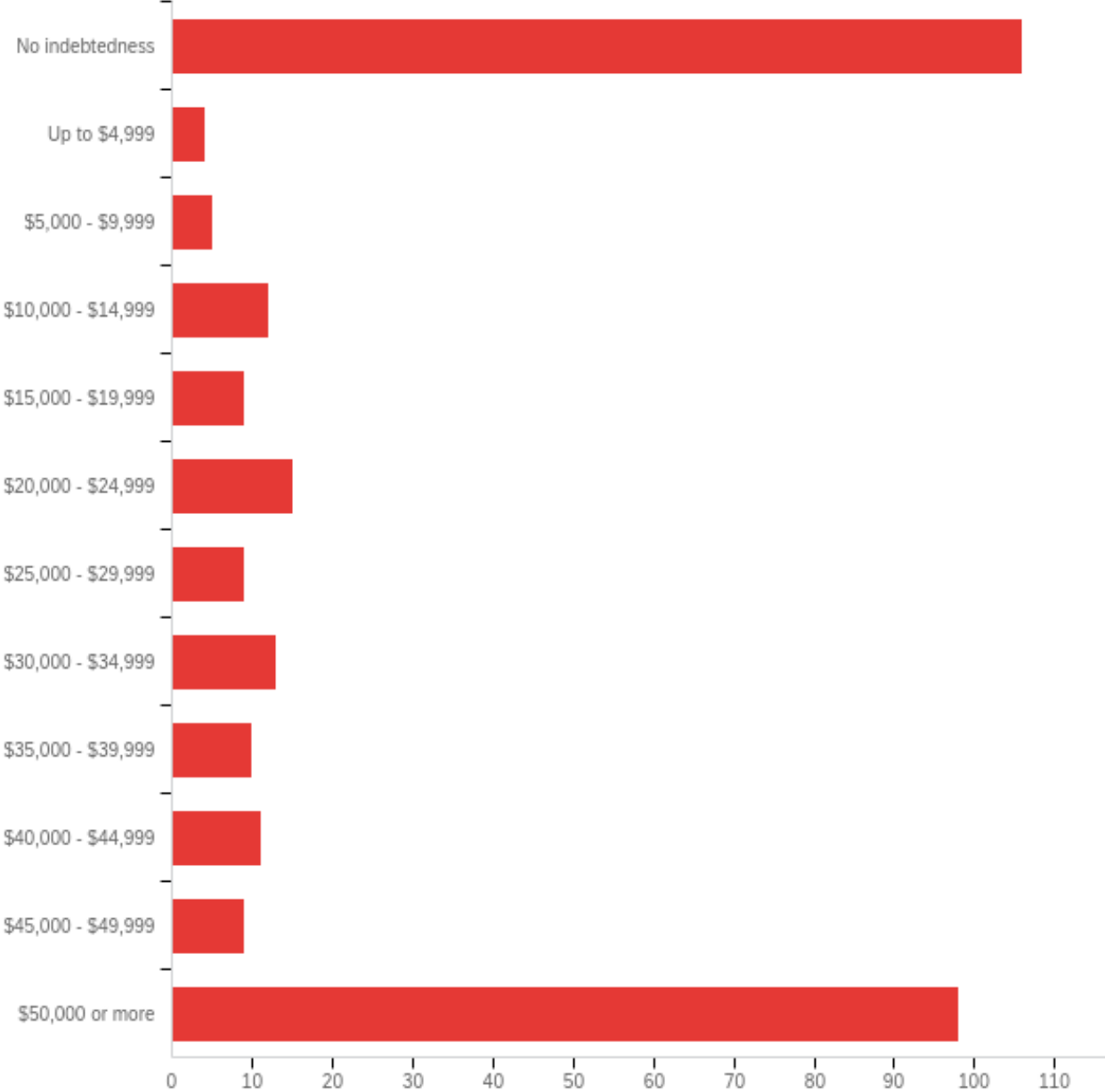

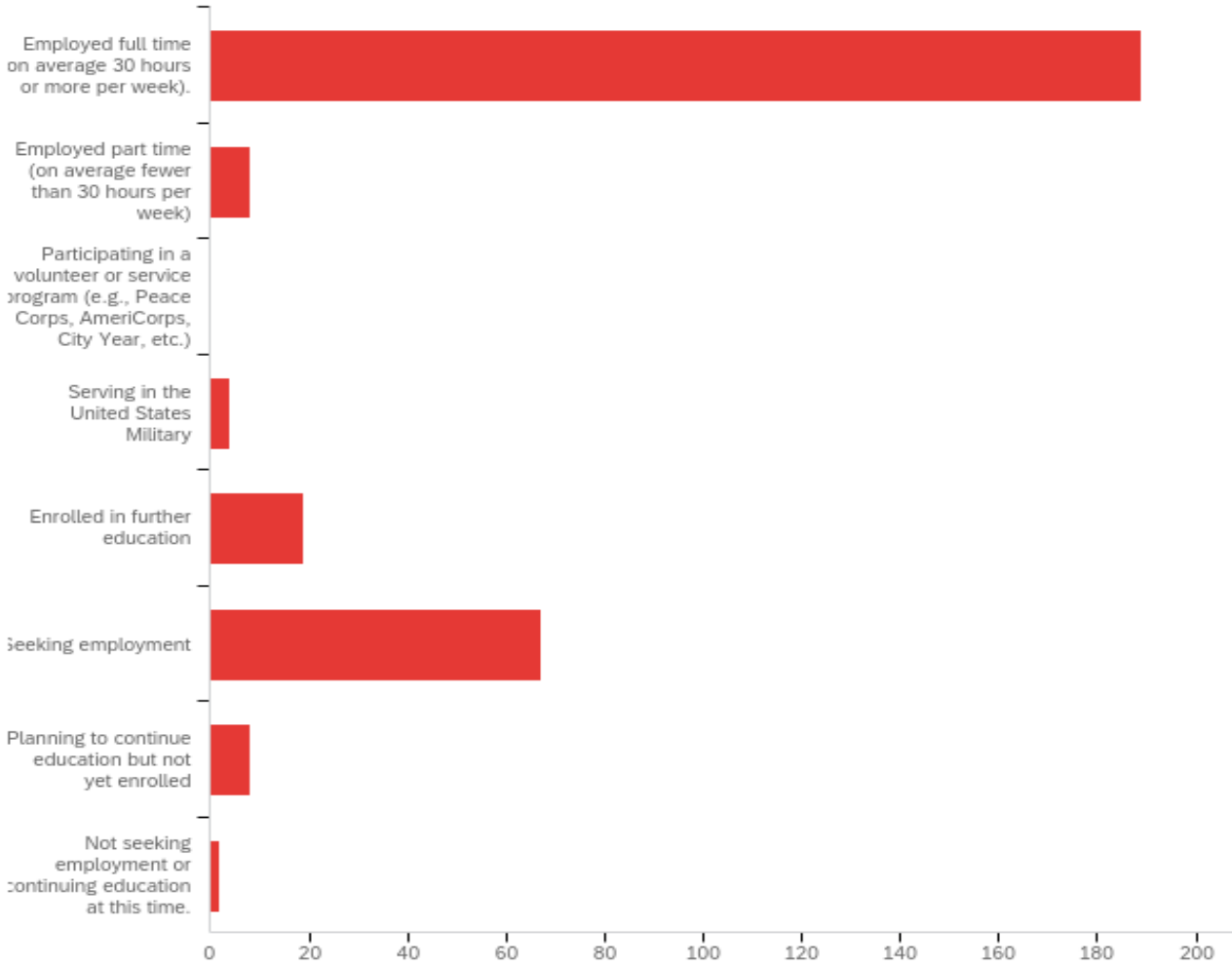
