


Q6 - Family Status




Q8 - Number of semesters enrolled to compete your degree (Note: One semester is equal to fall, spring, or summer, resulting in the potential of three semesters in one year).



Q9 - While pursuing your degree, did you





Q10 - During the last year of your studies, how many hours a week did you work while attending classes?



Q11 - Which of the following best describes your educational objective while attending Marshall University?




Q12 - Upon graduation, what was the dollar amount of your educational loan indebtedness?




