

University Assessment Report: Academic Year 2022-2023

Annual Program Assessment: 2021-2022

Assessment Committee members and the Assessment Office reviewed a total of 62 assessment reports. Twenty-nine (out of 60; 48%) undergraduate degree programs (in some cases majors within a degree program) submitted reports for review. Marshall's two undergraduate certificates did not submit assessment reports. Twenty-two graduate degree programs (out of 56; 39%), ten graduate certificate programs (out of 22; 45%), and one post-master's certificate program (out of 5; 20%) submitted reports. The Assessment Office sent evaluation letters to each of the programs reviewed, which included comments from de-identified reviewers when these were available. Additionally, each program received a rubric outlining performance in the following areas – *Student Learning Outcomes; Assessment Measures; Findings; Action Plan; Status Report.* Scoring statistics are provided in the charts below.

The one post-master's certificate assessment received scores of *3* for learning outcomes, assessment measures, and finding. The report included an action plan, but no status report.

General Education Assessment: 2022-2023

The Summer Assessment Team completed three assessments in May/June 2023. These included evaluation of a random sample of baseline assessments completed as part of UNI 100 in conjunction with fall 2022 Week of Welcome, followed by an evaluation of final assessments completed by the baseline sample at the end of FYS during fall 2022 and spring 2023. Second, the team conducted an evaluation of random samples of student artifacts aligned to Marshall's Baccalaureate Degree Profile (BDP) outcomes *Information Literacy, Integrative Thinking,* and *Metacognitive Thinking.* Third, the team evaluated a sample of capstone artifacts using the AAC&U Value rubric for *Written Communication* and an adapted AAC&U Value rubric for *Critical Thinking.* Additionally, faculty from the English Department assess written communication abilities of students in composition classes and faculty from the Communication Studies Department assess oral communication abilities of students in the basic public speaking courses. We conducted comprehensive five-year reviews for seven (7) undergraduate programs, eleven (11) graduate programs, one (1) undergraduate certificate program, and five (5) graduate certificate programs. Programs, in conjunction with the Offices of Assessment and Institutional Research and Planning, completed these reports using Taskstream. All reports were reviewed by the University's Academic Planning Committee (undergraduate) and Graduate Council (graduate). All programs that did not have programmatic accreditation also underwent peer review. Following these reviews, Marshall's provost and president reviewed each report. The following recommendations were approved by the Board of Governors on April 26, 2023.
