

### Q8 - Have you participated in ANY experiential learning opportunities since starting college at Marshall University?










Q12 - How many experiential learning opportunities have you engaged in during your time at Marshall University?



### Q13 - Which of the following best describes the type of employer for your most recent experiential learning opportunity?





Q14 - Was your experiential learning opportunity related to your major?





Q15 - Was your most recent experiential learning activity in-person, virtual, or hybrid?



















#### Q32 - How many jobs have you applied for?








