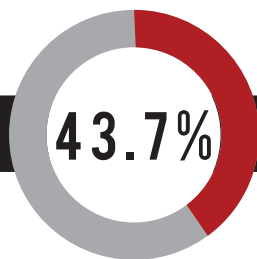

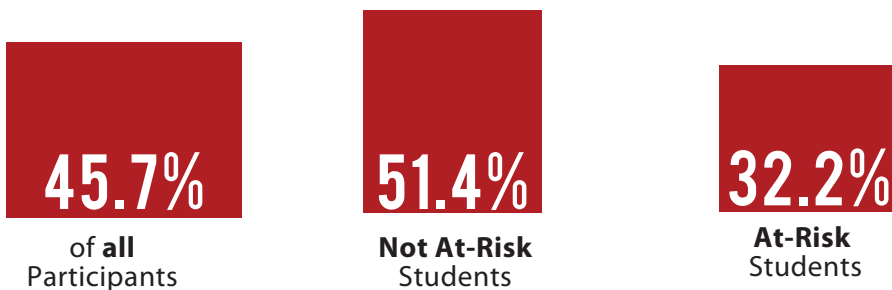

2014-2015 School Year

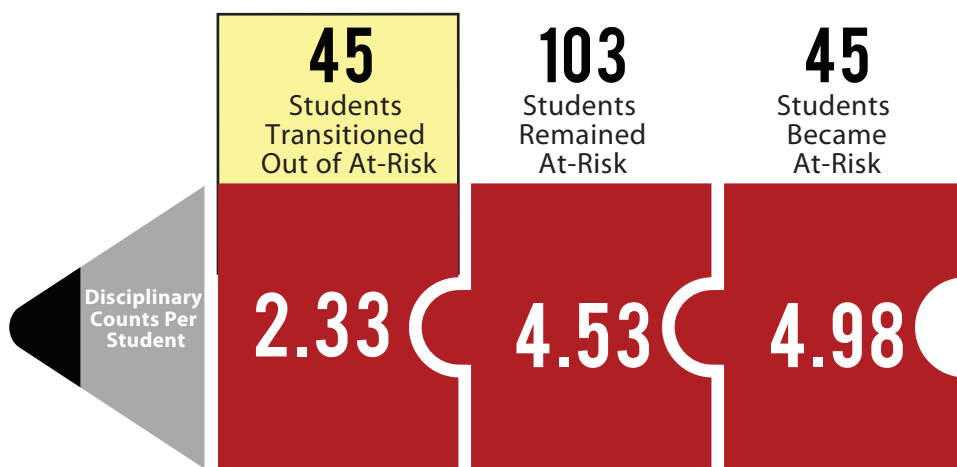


average percentage increase in GPA among "At-Risk" students

Disciplinary Counts & At-Risk Participants



Students with Consistent Improvement Over 2 School Years

- 42% began as "At-Risk"
- 48.6% average increase in GPA for these participants

Students in the Program for 5 School Years

- Almost 25% of students 1 transitioned and remained out of "At-Risk" for at least 3 years
 - 1 full GPA point improvement, more than **50% average increase**, from year 1

About WCCLC Program

The Wayne County Community Learning Centers (WCCLC) program is an educational collaborative of community and business partners, including the Wayne County Board of Education and Playmates Preschools & Child Development Centers. The Program provides after-school and summer assistance to Wayne County students. WCCLC offers 29 programs in Wayne County schools and Playmates locations, and annually serves more than 2,540 students on average.
