The Lewis College of Business Partners with Industry

Nucor Steel – The Lewis College of Business is working with the Nucor Steel team in Mason County to create internship opportunities for undergraduate and graduate students starting this fall. The college is discussing ways to work with Nucor Steel in conjunction with Marshall's College of Engineering and College of Science.

City National Bank – The Lewis College of Business is working with executives at City National Bank to develop more hands-on learning experiences for our students. We are fundraising for a student-driven investment fund. Department Chair Dr. Shaorong Zhang and Dr. Mohammad Uddin are planning innovative ways to provide wealth management experiences for finance students. The goal is to help LCOB students gain real-world trading experiences with equities, bonds, and other fixed income vehicles.

Northwestern Mutual – The college is collaborating with Northwestern Mutual to teach financial literacy and risk management principles. Northwestern Mutual professionals have prepared presentations for several spring marketing and sales classes. Recent alumni will present what Northwestern Mutual does for its clientele. Northwestern Mutual hopes to offer 10 paid student internships to Lewis College of Business students that will become Northwestern Mutual financial advisors upon graduation. The plan is to coordinate curriculum with faculty to introduce an assessment called the "Culture Index", a self-assessment survey that measures work-related preferences and careers matching the individual student's personality profiles.
