Delta Sigma Pi's attends their Grand Chapter Congress

From August 5-10, 3 LCOB students from our Delta Sigma Pi chapter travelled to the fraternity's 2025 Grand Chapter Congress in Palm Springs, CA! Clare Walker (FIN/ECN senior), Isabel Horter (Spring 2025 MKT graduate), Jamison Lewis (2nd-year MBA student) represented their Xi Upsilon chapter at this event, which is DSP's largest national conference.

Additionally, during the final fraternity business session, Dr. Margie McInerney was recognized posthumously by Xi Upsilon for her service within Delta Sigma Pi through this testimonial presented to all brothers in attendance:

"Earlier this year, the Xi Upsilon chapter lost a dear Brother and Faculty Initiate, Brother Marjorie McInerney.

As a student at Akron University, before graduating in 1975, Margie sought membership in Delta Sigma Pi. However, she was turned away as Delta Sigma Pi had not yet transitioned into a co-ed fraternity.

Years later, as a Marshall University faculty member, she provided kindness and compassion to a struggling Xi Upsilon chapter by helping them gain access to a display case for recruitment and general information purposes. Margie's kind gesture led to the chapter requesting she serve as Chapter Advisor. Margie accepted the role, albeit hesitantly, stating she disagreed with the Fraternity's historic stance on female membership.

Margie served the chapter by helping them navigate university and college of business requirements. With her support and willingness to help, the chapter moved to initiate Margie as a Faculty Initiate. On November 4, 2007, Xi Upsilon initiated Margie as a Brother of Delta Sigma Pi.

Since that time and before her passing, though no longer serving as Xi Upsilon's Chapter Advisor, she helped the chapter through hard times. With every visit back, when greeted

with the grip and a, "Hello, Brother!", a smile came to her face. I believe it's because she was proud to be a Deltasig!

Margie was loved and will be missed immensely. She was a person of commerce, a Delta Sigma Pi, the world is better because she dwelt upon it!"
