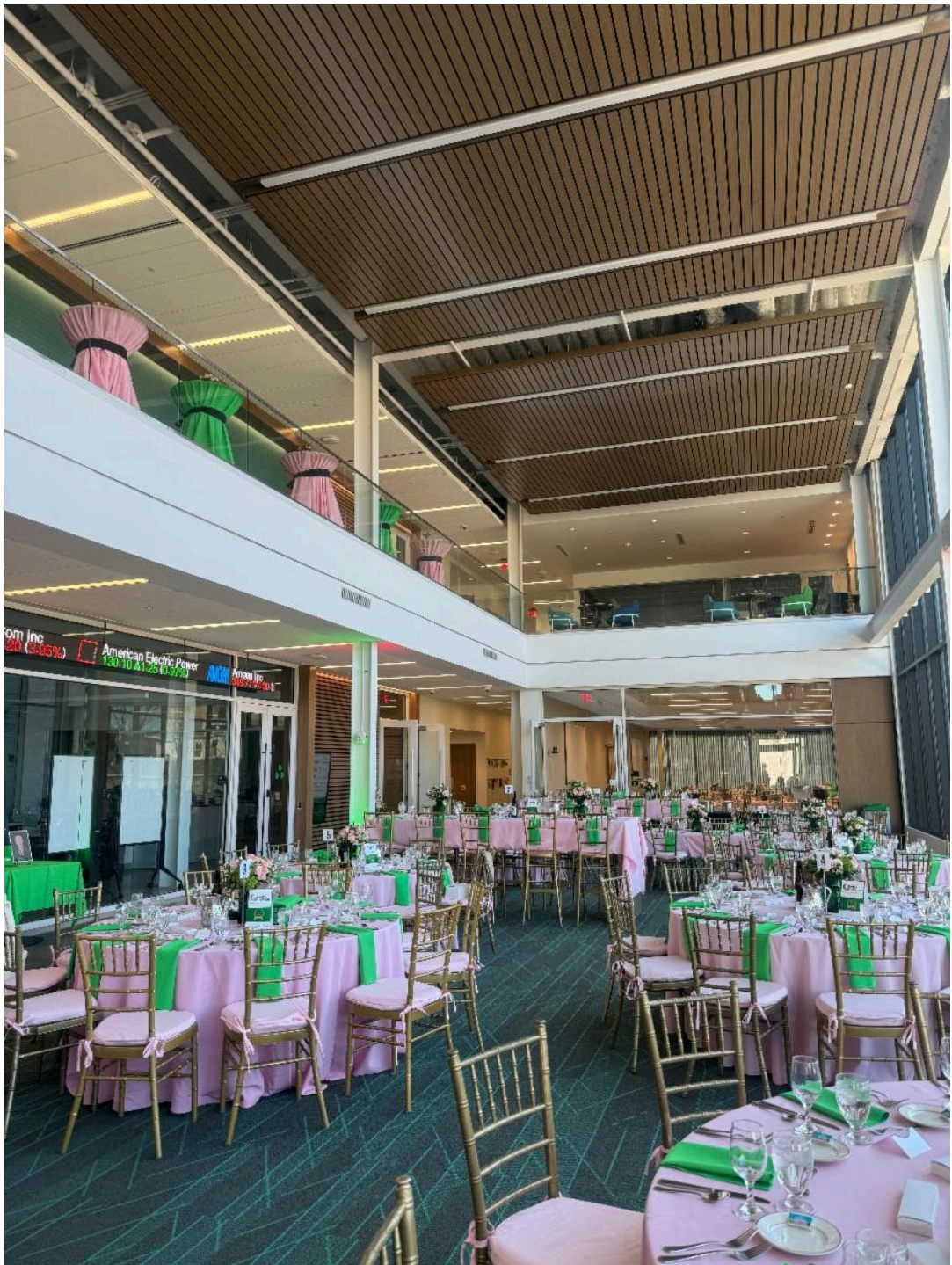
Business Hall of Fame 2026 Induction Ceremony
