


PROGRAMS

Marshall University's Master of Business Administration (M.B.A.) and Master of Accountancy degree programs now offer a new online option, taught by full-time university faculty, which complement the current M.B.A. offerings for working professionals. Students complete their degrees in two years with the same academic requirements as those taking classes on campus.

The Lewis College of Business offers a Bachelor of Arts degree in General Business. This degree is delivered 100% online. This means students can complete the whole degree without coming to campus and without having to meet at designated times to complete lessons. The program is flexible and convenient.

The Online BA in General Business degree does not require you to choose a major. The "major" comes from 24 hours of any combination of upper level college classes. For example, you can take classes in management, marketing, accounting, economics/finance to create your major. This provides broad business knowledge that you can use in a variety of careers.











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The Lewis College of Business, Brad D. Smith Schools of Business is pleased to announce the construction of its new Brad D. Smith Center for Business and Innovation. We are sincerely thankful for the generous gift of Brad D. and Alys Smith that is the cornerstone for creating the new facility. The building will house a next-generation business school focused on empowering students to achieve their professional and entrepreneurial dreams, while making a positive impact on the local and regional economy.

Currently under construction, the new facility is expected to measure 77,000 gross square feet and to be complete by the fall of 2023. Classes are projected to begin in January 2024. The building will be a new state-of-the-art facility with space designs that are organic and capable of growing and morphing to keep pace with a rapidly evolving business environment. The Brad D. Smith Center will accommodate various pedagogical instructional modes including traditional lecture, experiential learning, and case discussions. It will feature a forum and auditorium, and contain computer and finance labs, offices, meeting rooms, centers, and student spaces. The facility will serve as a center for the economic development of the region, which is an important component of the college's mission. The building will be equipped with conference facilities for both small and large business gatherings. It will serve as an incubator for management and practice, and will be a hub for student-centric activities crucial to their learning, interaction, and collaboration.
