

## How to Request an Overload for a Course that is Currently Full/Closed

1. If a course is full, it will typically show up with a red bar in the course listings. The course may appear open, without the red bar, but it is still closed for various reasons. You will need to contact the program chair or the designated faculty/staff member in that department to request overload approval for the course. Use the tables below to match the course subject to the appropriate college and identify the correct contact person.
2. Compose an email to the department Chair or designated faculty staff to submit the overload request. The email should include the reason you need to enroll in the specific course you are requesting. For example, you may need it because it is the only course that fits in your current schedule. You can see an example email below.

Subject: Request to Enroll in [Course Name & Number]

3. If your request is approved by the chair/designated faculty/staff, forward that to your advisor, and they can enroll you in the course directly. Please forward the email directly; do not send a screenshot to your advisor. We need a direct email for documentation.

\*FYI

Permission to join a course that is full or closed is at the discretion of the Program Chair/Designated Faculty/Staff member. Please allow at least 2 days to receive a response from the instructor/program Chair. If your request to join the course is not approved, you will need to select an alternate course. You can work with your advisor to choose an alternate course.
