# The President's Charge to the Graduates

It is my pleasant privilege, ladies and gentlemen of the graduating class, to welcome you into the great body of 19,476 graduates of Marshall University. No two of you have had exactly the same experiences at Marshall nor will you carry away with you the same memories. Yet all of you have had four experiences in common:
