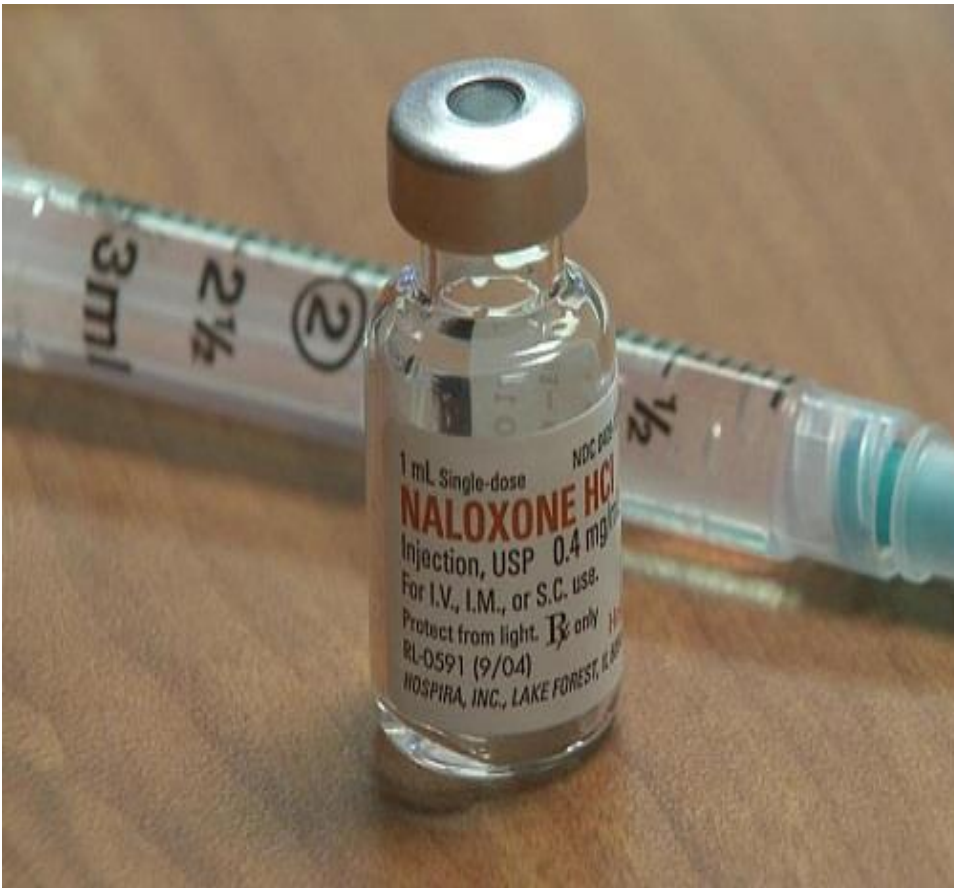


NALOXONE TRAINING
