WHAT IS THE HEART OF APPALACHIA **EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY CENTER?**

The Heart of Appalachia Educational Opportunity Center is a program funded by the U.S. Department of Education that helps adult students who want to pursue college or vocational/technical training.

Educational Opportunity Centers (EOCs) are located throughout the United States and primarily serve displaced or underemployed workers. EOC counselors work one-onone with clients, helping them to choose a college and a suitable financial aid program.

The Heart of Appalachia Educational Opportunity Center serves adults from Cabell, Mason, Lincoln and Wayne Counties in West Virginia.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE HEART OF APPALACHIA **EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY CENTER?**

- High School graduates or TASC/GED graduates
- Individuals who did not complete high school and wish to obtain a diploma
- Individuals who left a college or vocational training program before completion and wish to resume their education
- Adults whose family income meets Federal guidelines
- Adults who are first-generation college students (neither parent completed a 4-year degree)

WHAT SERVICES ARE OFFERED? **HOW MUCH DO THEY COST?**

The following services are FREE to those who qualify for the program:

Career Guidance

Through career counseling and testing, we can help you make informed decisions about the career to pursue and what schools offer the programs that will help you reach your career goals.

Educational Information

We will provide information on different colleges and vocational training program. We can refer adults seeking a high school equivalency diploma to the nearest Adult Basic Education center or High School Equivalency testing center.

Academic Advising

We will help with planning college majors and course selection.

Admission Forms

We will assist you in filling out admissions forms for the school vou select.

Financial Aid Assistance

We will guide you through the financial aid process, answering questions about completing the FAFSA. We will also assist with defaulted student loan reconciliation.
