Report Research FS committee

The Research Committee met on October 19, 2023 (Teams) and November 27, 2023.

• Changes in General Procedure

Chair Julie Snyder-Yuli suggested to consider the election of a Vice-Chair. Details can be provided to the Faculty Senate Office upon request (Word document of the minutes).

• Budget and meeting scheduling

Available budget expected to be available for Quinlan awards: \$12,000 to \$15,000. Committee is considering meeting more frequently than 3 times a year to allow a better distribution of funding. Schedule would be as follows:

- 1. For Cycle 1, meetings on November 1, January 1, March 1.
- 2. For Cycle 2 April 1 for award applications (Quinlan, Research Committee, Summer Research Awards, Summer Scholars Awards) for conferences between March 1 and October 1. May 1 to review newly submitted applications for that cycle.
 - Creating a Process for Better Decisions on How to Award Funding When It Exceeds Funding Amounts and Discussing Different Review Processes to Better Distribute the Work
 - Vote for Awards

Quinlan: \$14,500 (initial budget about \$7,250 each cycle)

For Cycle 1: 29 applications received.

Applications 3 from College of Arts and Media

5 from LCOB, 4 approved, 1 ineligible

2 from COEPD, 2 approved (note: 1 was ineligible)

6 from CHP (College of Health Professions),

5 from COLA,

8 from the COS.

Final vote for COS, CHP, and COLA applications was held during the 11/27/23 meeting.

Research Committee (Budget: \$2,000)

3 applications: 2 from COLA, 1 from COS.

All 3 applications were approved.

Student Research Scholars (Budget: \$3,000)

6 applications for Cycle 1 requesting a total of \$1,500.

Applications: 2 from the College of Engineering and Computer Sciences

4 from the College of Arts and Media.

After discussions during the 11/27/23 meeting, out of a total of twenty-nine applications, fifteen \$500.00 awarded, one \$400.00, and one \$250.00 were granted for a total of \$8,225. The remaining \$6,275 will be awarded during the Spring cycle.

• Additional discussions

- a. The committee decided to form a subcommittee(s) to generate a better process for reviewing and awarding Quinlan and Summer Scholars funding. Volunteers for this committee were Shane Welch, Richard Egleton, Virginia Liang, and Julie Snyder-Yuly.
- b. The committee decided on a potential schedule in which they would meet every month with extra meetings as necessary to distribute funds more quickly. It was also decided to move to in-person meetings.
