## AT A GLANCE HALL COMPARISON

### FIRST YEAR HALLS NORTH & SOUTH

**Location:** East campus, close to the Rec Center, basketball arena and football stadium.

**Room Style:** Traditional double rooms with a private bathroom.

**Community:** Only open to first-year students. Co-ed buildings.

**Amenities:**

- Lounges and study spaces on each floor
- Laundry rooms in both buildings

**Support:** Environment tailored to support students transitioning to college life. Often host events and mentoring opportunities. Resident Advisors available on each floor.

**Cost:** **\$3,892.00** per semester



### BUSKIRK HALL

**Location:** Next to Buskirk Field and close to the Memorial Student Center and academic buildings.

**Room Style:** Traditional single and double rooms with community bathrooms.

**Community:** Female only. Mostly upper-level students with a designated freshman floor.

**Amenities:**

- Social lounge space on first floor
- Study lounge, kitchen and laundry facilities on each floor
- Close proximity to academic buildings

**Support:** Strong sense of community. Resident Advisors available on each floor. Programs to support both upper-level students and freshman.

**Cost:**

- Double Occupancy: **\$3,079.00**
- Single Occupancy: **\$3,987.00**



### TWIN TOWERS EAST & WEST

**Location:** Near the Memorial Student Center, tennis courts, and basketball arena. Co-ed buildings.

**Room Style:** Traditional single or double rooms. Community bathrooms.

**Community:** Co-ed building. Contain freshman floors.

**Amenities:**

- Laundry room on each floor
- Large lounges, game areas, and learning centers in each building.
- Connected to each other by the Towers Marketplace dining facility.

**Support:** A mix of independence and support with Resident Advisors available on each floor. Programs to support both upper-level students and freshman.

**Cost:**

- Double Occupancy: **\$3,079.00**
- Single Occupancy: **\$3,987.00**



### MARSHALL COMMONS GIBSON, HAYMAKER, WELLMAN & WILLIS HALLS

**Location:** Between 5th and 6th Avenues, next to Harless Dining Hall.

**Room Style:** Suite-style with three types of suites available.

**Community:** Co-ed buildings with mostly upper-level students. Willis Hall is designated for Honors College students.

**Amenities:**

- Single or double bedrooms with shared living space.
- Bathrooms are shared with suitemates.
- Laundry facilities available in each building.

**Support:** More independent living and a quieter environment. Resident Advisors available on each floor.

**Cost:**

Double Occupancy: **\$3,606.00**  
Single Occupancy: **\$4,345.00**
