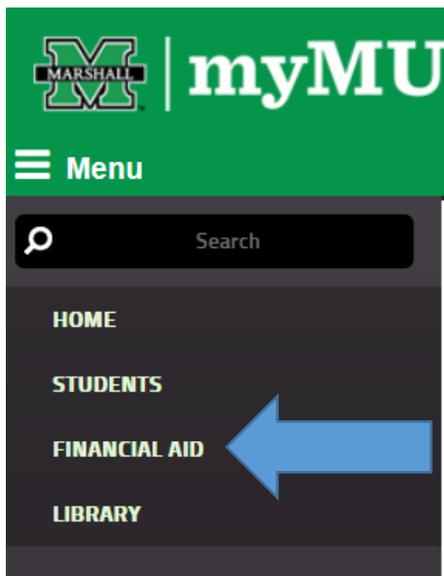


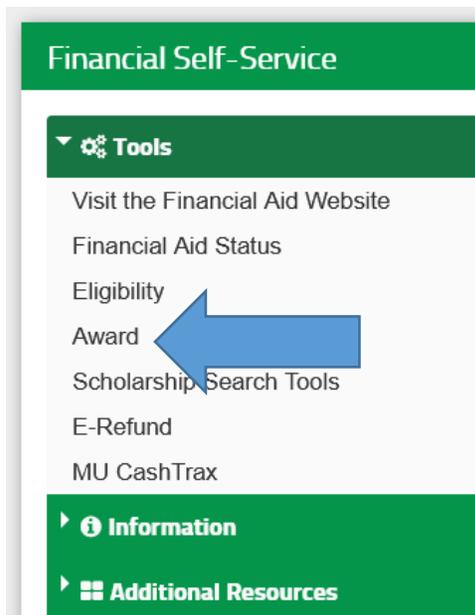
How To Apply for Summer Financial Aid

- ✓ Go to myMU.marshall.edu
- ✓ Enter your MUNET Account and password and click the LOGIN button
- ✓ Click on Menu in the upper left-hand corner and select Financial Aid
