STEPS TO APPLY

- Complete, sign, and return the **application for admission** to Marshall University's English Language Institute to international@marshall.edu
- Submit the **non-refundable application fee**. Check or money order made payable to Marshall University. To pay by credit or debit card, please contact the Office of International Student Services.
- Complete, sign, and return the **application for undergraduate or graduate admission** to Marshall University (only applicable to students who plan to enroll in a degree-seeking program after completing the Marshall University English Language Institute.
- Request all **official* academic transcripts and examination results** to be sent to Marshall University. Transcripts and exams must be sent directly from the designated school or examination official to Marshall University. All transcripts and exams must be in English and the original language and contain all academic grades and courses.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

- JUNE 15 for students applying to the fall semester beginning in August
- OCTOBER 15 for students applying to the spring semester beginning in January
- MARCH 15 for students applying to the summer terms beginning in May, June, or July

*Online program applicants must meet the regular Marshall application deadline of two weeks prior to the start of a term

What is an Official Credential?

*OFFICIAL credentials or evaluations are only those received by the Marshall University admissions office directly from the issuing institution or agency. Student copies of transcripts, evaluations, faxed copies of college transcripts, or credentials sent from the applicant or any other third party are not considered official.

AFTER ADMISSION

- If requesting a Form I-20 or DS-2019, submit the Financial Certification Form at: www.marshall.edu/iss/financialcert. Submit via email a copy of your valid passport and sufficient financial documentation from all sources of funding, which may include one or more of the following: affidavit of support, bank statement, loan letter, financial guarantee letter, or scholarship award letter.
- Submit enrollment deposit online at: https://epay.marshall.edu/secure/cgi/stoenrollmentdeposit.cgi. The enrollment deposit is refundable through May 1 for the Fall semester and December 1 for the spring semester.
- Receive the Form I-20 or DS-2019. Forms I-20 and DS-2019 must be released directly to the student. Students may arrange shipping through UEMS EShip Global once the Form I-20 or DS-2019 is prepared. Students will receive instructions to pay for shipping via email.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

English Placement

Upon arrival, students admitted to the Marshall University English Language Institute will take a placement exam to determine English level placement. Students enrolled in the Marshall University English Language Institute will have all rights, privileges, and responsibilities of all students attending Marshall University.

Receiving Form I-20 or DS-2019

After all application materials are received, credentials will be evaluated. If admissible, a letter of admission will be sent via email to the email address specified on the application along with steps to receive the Form I-20 or DS-2019. Form I-20 or DS-2019 is required to apply for an F-1 or J-1 visa for entry to the United States. To receive the I-20 or DS-2019, students must supply the following documents after receiving the official offer letter to the Marshall University English Language Institute:

- ✓ All required admissions credentials
- ✓ Sufficient proof of financial support from all sources of funding, including Financial Certification Form and all supporting financial documents
- ✓ Copy of valid passport
- ✓ Submission of enrollment deposit

Once the Certificate of Eligibility Form I-20 or DS-2019 is issued, you will be sent shipping instructions via email. Students are required to arrange shipping through UEMS eShipGlobal to receive the Form I-20 or DS-2019. Forms I-20 and DS-2019 may not be released to agents or recruiters. Students must directly request exception requests to iss@marshall.edu. Please note the I-20 may only be issued for in-person study.

Arrival Information

Once Form I-20 or DS-2019 is received, students should pay the I-901 SEVIS fee and make a visa appointment at the nearest embassy or consulate. Following visa issuance, new F-1 and J-1 students should plan to arrive to the United States no earlier than 30 days prior to the start of their program. If you are transferring a SEVIS record, please be sure to notify the Office of International Student Services at iss@marshall.edu. Students should inform the Office of International Students Services of all travel plans by submitting the Arrival Survey at:

https://www.marshall.edu/iss/arrival-form/. The Office of International Student Services at Marshall University provides a reliable airport pick-up service the week before every semester begins. Marshall University has two airports nearby where the Office of International Student Services staff can perform pick-ups: Huntington Tri-State Aiport (HTS) and Charleston Yeager Airport (CRW). Huntington Tri-State Airport is about 15 minutes from Marshall's campus, and Charleston Yeager Airport is about 50 minutes from campus. There is an airport pick-up fee of \$50 for all pick-ups at Huntington Tri-State Airport and a \$150 fee for all pick-ups made at Charleston Yeager Airport. Health Insurance

All international students are required to provide proof of health insurance prior to registration for each term at Marshall University. Please visit www.marshall.edu/iss/healthinsurance for more information.

Orientation & Check-In

All international students are required to check-in with the Office of International Student Services no later than the Monday following the start of classes for the semester. Failure to check-in may result in withdrawal of courses and/or termination of the Form I-20 or DS-2019. All international students are required to attend the mandatory orientation prior to the start of the program.
