In addition to serving as coach of the US National Team, Dr. Brunty has been the Faculty Advisor and coach of Marshall's highly successful Collegiate Cyber Defense Competition Team. Under his guidance, the team has consistently performed at a high level in various Capture the Flag (CTF) and Red versus Blue (RvB) competitions. Notable achievements include a first-place national championship finish in the National Cyber League (Spring 2020) and four consecutive Top Ten finishes from 2018 to 2020. Additionally, he has mentored various high school teams participating in the Air Force Association's CyberPatriot Competition that has won past state championships in the state of

Dr. Brunty's expertise in cybersecurity, digital forensics,

and education, coupled with his academic background

and professional experience, position him as a leading figure in the field. His commitment to mentoring and guiding students in this rapidly evolving domain demonstrates his dedication to fostering the next generation of cybersecurity professionals.


