The [Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education \(ACPE\)](#) has extended the accreditation term for the Marshall University School of Pharmacy doctoral program through June 30, 2030.

Program accreditation provides a national basis for quality assurance. [Marshall University's pharmacy doctorate is one of three ACPE-accredited programs](#) in West Virginia. The program first earned accreditation status in 2016 when it was awarded the initial two-year term standard for new programs. The accreditation process includes on-site evaluations and written reports and other communication from the School of Pharmacy.
