The Accompanying Assistant Program serves to aid students in preparing degree recitals and other special events in which an accompanist's participation is integral to the event. For degree recitals, fees are intended to compensate an accompanist for individual preparation time, two rehearsals, one recital hearing and one performance. Additional services are arranged with the accompanists at additional expense to the student. A rehearsal may not exceed 75 minutes. Recital fees presume that the accompanist is performing on the majority of the program. Rates will be reduced if half or less of the program uses piano. Recital length is based on minimum stands of:

- BFA Senior Recital of 50 minutes, Junior Recital of 30 minutes
- BA Music Education Senior Recital Option I – 50 minutes (BFA or Senior Recital),
Option II: 30 minutes (BFA Junior Recital)
- Graduate Recital of 60 minutes
