- 1. American Heart Association Basic Cardiac Life Support for Healthcare Providers
- 2. American Safety Health Institute CPR Pro for the Professional Rescuer
- 3. American Red Cross Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers
- 4. American Red Cross Adult & Pediatric CPR/AED
- 5. International Occupational Health Safety Association BLS for Healthcare Providers
