1.6 History:

1.6.1 This policy amends and replaces MUBOG GA-8, Smoking (effective March 8, 20060 and amends and replaces MUBOG GA-8, Tobacco Policy (effective July 1, 2013),

2 Policy.

- 2.1 The use of tobacco products is prohibited on any university-owned or controlled property. Prohibited tobacco products include, but are not limited to, cigarettes, e-cigarettes, vaping, chewing tobacco, dip, pipes, cigars, cigarillos, hookah or water pipe smoking, snus and snuff. This policy applies to faculty, staff, students, contractors, vendors, and visitors. It applies to any and all indoor and outdoor events, subject to the exception provided for in Section 2.3.
- 2.2 There shall be no advertising, sale, or free sampling of tobacco products on University property. Littering the campus with the remains of tobacco products or any other related waste product is prohibited.
- 2.3 Events that attract a large number of off-campus visitors to the Marshall University campus may be exempted on a case-by-case basis with the approval of the Senior Vice President for Operations or appropriate Vice President, provided that all smoking be restricted to outdoor smoking areas.
