In addition, candidates must earn a passing score on Praxis II (specialty area test in School Psychology) to be eligible for internship.

All candidates seeking certification must pass the appropriate PRAXIS certification exam prior to the internship. Failure to return the signed Plan of Study within 30 days will automatically indicate acceptance of the Plan of Study. Plan of Study must be completed on all admitted degree candidates within the first semester of enrollment.

NOTE: This plan should be agreed to and signed by all parties prior to the end of the candidate's first semester in the program. Transfer of credit for a required area must be done at the time of the initial Plan of Study and listed in the approved alternative area. If this Plan of Study is later revised, the Program Director must approve the change by signing and dating.
