MPH Application Checklist

- Application for Graduate Admission to Marshall University.**
Do this first, as it is the step that creates your file with Graduate Admissions, and assures all your other information is expeditiously processed. Note that the Graduate College is the conduit to address issues such as state residency status, as well as requirements for TOEFL and other prerequisites for foreign students.
- Submission of the MPH Program Supplemental Application.**
This single document includes your personal statement.
- Completion of a Bachelor's degree or higher**
We have clarified that one may be admitted prior to receipt of a bachelor's degree, if graduation is anticipated prior to matriculation in graduate studies. For example, some student applications are made while a student is still completing requirements for spring or summer graduation. Such applications are made on a *Conditional* basis (i.e., you must satisfy the scheduled graduation requirement).
- Official Transcripts**
Transcripts must be received *directly* by the Graduate College from all degree-granting institutions. Do not attempt to send your own copies.
- Submission of test scores**
If you are submitting another doctoral level health professions examination (MCAT, PCAT), please assure that those exams scores have been sent to the Graduate College. All examination reports submitted must reflect current valid scores. Note that applicants already holding doctoral level health practitioner degrees *as well as* the J.D. degree are exempt from the standardized exam requirement, but may submit current test scores in support of an application.
- Submission of three letters of recommendation**
At least two of these must be from faculty if the applicant has engaged in full-time post-secondary study in the previous five years.
- Resume of work history or curriculum vitae**
Either document should reflect both post-secondary work and study.
